



Tata Power E-Waste Management Policy

We at Tata Power emphasize our commitment to a clean, safe and healthy environment, and operation of our facilities in an environmentally sensitive and responsible manner through the Corporate Environment Policy.

The Tata Power E-Waste Management Policy, derived from the above, reaffirms our commitment to environmental protection by ensuring proper management of electronic waste. We recognize that as the Company strives to be a lead adopter of technology in all areas of its operations, there is a substantial generation of E-Waste.

Through this policy, Tata Power will:

- Procure IT and OT system hardware from vendors who are likely to take back E-Waste in future.
- Minimize generation of E-Waste by extending the useful life of electronic hardware.
- Carry out E-Waste disposal only through E-Waste handlers/recyclers authorized by Central or State Pollution Control Boards.
- Educate the employees on the hazards of E-Waste.

A list of E-Waste typically generated in Tata Power is given below for reference:

1. Personal Computers (CPU, mouse, key board and monitors included)	6. SCADA systems (Servers, monitors, keyboards, Remote Terminal Units included)
2. Lap tops	7. Printers
3. Communication equipments (Multiplexers, wireless equipments, modems, telephones, EPABX, Routers, Switches, Facsimile included)	8. Plant Automation equipment(PLCs, Servers, Electronic Sensors, Numerical Relays, Energy meters)
4. Photo copying machines and toners	9. Electronic Testing equipments
5. Pocket and desk calculators, Projectors, Digital Cameras	10. Batteries used in electronic equipments
