# Hong Kong's leader lays out future tied to Beijing after political unrest

Lam defended Xi's actions to exert greater control

LAST YEAR, HONG Kong Chief Executive Carrie Lam only made it through a few lines of her annual policy address before pro-democracy lawmakers forced her to flee the chamber and deliver it virtually.

On Wednesday, she spoke for more than two hours to a legislative body with no members of an opposition that has long resisted the city's integration with the mainland. After quoting Chinese President Xi Jinping at the outset, Lam defended Beijing's sweeping actions to exert greater political control over Hong Kong while outlining steps aimed at interlocking the two economies.

The address, which was delayed so Lam could consult

Communist Party leaders in Beijing, featured a slew of references to the mainland compared with last year's abbreviated speech. They included a section on the benefits of a sweeping China-imposed national security law, which prompted the US to revoke Hong Kong's special trading privileges and sanction top Chinese and Hong Kong leaders, including Lam.

The 24,000-word speech featured few immediate measures that would provide relief for a city reeling from a new wave of virus infections, an economy in deep contraction and worsening wealth inequality. The Hang Seng Index pared an earlier gain of as much as 1.7% to close up 0.3% on the day.

"For many small businesses that are still fighting to survive they would be disappointed, especially now that the city is entering the fourth wave of Covid outbreak," said Tommy Wu, senior economist with Oxford Economics in Hong Kong.

"The main objective of today's policy speech was really



about Hong Kong-China integration in the post-national security law era," he said. "Many of the economic policies mentioned in the speech have a mainland China element to it, from finance to tech to youth employment." Lam's remarks reinforced the extent to which Hong Kong's future is tethered to China, a trend that has only accelerated as Beijing moved to snuff out any political dissent in the former British colony. While the city remains a conduit for Chinese companies to raise capital,

more Western businesses are questioning Hong Kong's viability as a financial hub -- particularly as doubts grow over the independence of the judiciary. Lam spent a sizable part of her speech promoting the Greater Bay Area concept that seeks to create a Silicon Valley-style regional economic zone with the nearby mainland cities of Guangzhou and Shenzhen. She spoke about various programs to boost employment opportunities for young Hong Kongers to take jobs in

the mainland, including wage subsidies for Hong Kong tech companies to deploy staff in mainland cities and funding for a cross-boundary youth entrepreneurship plan.

"The biggest opportunity lies with central government support to tap into the mainland market," Lam said. "This is the growth engine."

However, critics in Hong Kong see the project as an attempt to further erode the former British colony's autonomy following Beijing's moves to crack down on political speech and assembly. Opposition politician Claudia Mo, who resigned along with other pro-democracy politicians this month, criticised Lam's remarks on the Greater Bay Area, saying on Twitter that it would mark the "end of Hong Kong as we know it."

While some young people in Hong Kong would take up the offer to look for work in China, the majority are unlikely to jump at the opportunity, said Jean-Pierre Cabestan, chair professor of political science at Hong Kong.

## 'Jallikattu' is India's official Oscar entry

MALAYALAM FEATURE "JALLIKATTU", directed by Lijo Jose Pellissery, has been selected as India's official entry for the International Feature Film category at the 93rd Academy Awards, the Film Federation of India (FFI) announced on Wednesday.

"Jallikattu", which was unanimously chosen from 27 entries across Hindi, Marathi and other languages, is about a tribe of men coming together to stop a bull that has run amok in their village.

Pellissery, who has previously made critically-acclaimed features like "Angamaly Diaries" and "Ea Ma Yau", said he is "extremely happy" that his movie has been selected for 2021 Oscars.

"Extremely happy to know that 'Jallikattu' gained entry in the Oscar. This is a moment of happiness for all those who 'raced' for the film," the filmmaker told PTI.

The film, which derives its name from the popular-yet-controversial bull-taming event from the South, is based on a short story by Hareesh. It features actors Antony Varghese, Chemban Vinod Jose, Sabumon Abdusamad and Santhya Balachandran.

Asked if the film was a "unanimous choice", filmmaker Rahul Rawail, Chairman, Jury Board, The Film Federation of India (FFI) said "Jallikattu" was a favourite.

"It is a film that really brings out the raw problems which are there in human beings, that we are worse than animals," Rawail told reporters in an online press conference.

## Mutations not making virus able to spread more rapidly: Study

THE COVID-19-CAUSING coronavirus is mutating as it spreads around the world in the pandemic, but none of the mutations currently documented appears to be making it able to spread more rapidly, scientists said on Wednesday.

In a study using a global dataset of virus genomes from 46,723 people with Covid-19 from 99 countries, researchers identified more than 12,700 mutations, or changes, in the SARS-CoV-2 virus.

"Fortunately, we found that none of these mutations are making Covid-19 spread more rapidly," said Lucy van Dorp, a professor at University College London's Genetics Institute and one of the co-lead researchers on the study.

She added, however: "We need to remain vigilant and continue monitoring new mutations, particularly as vaccines get rolled out."

"Viruses are known to mutate all the time, and some - such as flu viruses - change more frequently than others.

Most mutations are neutral, but some can be either advantageous or detrimental to the virus, and some can make vaccines against them less effective. When viruses change like this, vaccines against them have to be adapted regularly to ensure they are hitting the right target.

With the SARS-CoV-2 virus, the first vaccines to show effi-

causing the disease it causes could get regulatory approval and begin to be used to immunise people before the end of the year.

Francois Balloux, a UCL professor who also worked on the study, said that its findings, for now, posed no threat to Covid-19 vaccine efficacy, but cautioned that the imminent introduction of vaccines could exert new selective pressures on the virus to mutate to try to evade the human immune system.

"The news on the vaccine front looks great," he said. "The virus may well acquire vaccine-escape mutations in the future, but we're confident we'll be able to flag them up promptly, which would allow updating the vaccines in time if required."

## Britain's Duchess Meghan speaks about miscarriage

MEGHAN, THE DUCHESS OF Sussex, has revealed that she had a miscarriage in July, an extraordinarily personal disclosure coming from a high-profile British royal.

The wife of Prince Harry and former actress wrote about the experience in detail in an opinion article published in the New York Times on Wednesday, saying that it took place one morning when she was caring for Archie, the couple's son.

"I knew, as I clutched my firstborn child, that I was losing my second," Meghan wrote, describing how she felt a sharp cramp after picking up Archie from his crib, and dropped to the floor with him in her arms, humming a lullaby to keep them both calm.

Meghan described how she and her husband were both in tears as she lay in a hospital bed hours later.

"Losing a child means carrying an almost unbearable grief, experienced by many but talked about by few," she wrote. "Yet despite the staggering



commonality of this pain, the conversation remains taboo, riddled with (unwarranted) shame, and perpetuating a cycle of solitary mourning," she

wrote. Approximately one in five women may experience a miscarriage in the first 12 weeks of pregnancy, according to

Britain's professional body for obstetricians and gynaecologists, which says the topic is under-researched and care for parents under-resourced.

Meghan and Harry have consistently used their profile to highlight mental health issues, and several British charities active in the fields of miscarriage research and support said her article would help people going through pain and grief. "Mothers like Meghan sharing their stories is a vital step in breaking down that stigma and shame," said Sophie King, a midwife.

## Beyonce dominates Grammy nods; The Weeknd calls process 'corrupt'

BEYONCE DOMINATED NOMINATIONS for the 2021 Grammy Awards on Tuesday in a field that favoured alternative artists over mainstream musicians, topped by a stunning snub for Canadian singer The Weeknd, who called the process "corrupt."


Beyonce's nine nods made her the second most nominated Grammy artist in history, with a total of 79, and came through projects that celebrated Black culture in a year of racial turmoil in the United States.

The biggest shutout for the highest honours in the music industry was The Weeknd, whose critically acclaimed album "After Hours," was No. 1 on the Billboard 200 charts for four weeks.

Variety called the omission of the R&B singer, who has been chosen to play the half-time show at the Super Bowl next year, "the biggest snub in memory."

The Weeknd, in a Twitter post, said: "The Grammys remain corrupt. You owe me, my fans and the industry transparency."

The Recording Academy's chair and interim CEO, Harvey



Mason, said in a written statement that he understood The Weeknd's disappointment.

"We were thrilled when we found out he would be performing at the upcoming Super Bowl and we would have loved to have him also perform on the Grammy stage the weekend before. Unfortunately, every year, there are fewer nominations than the number of deserving artists," Mason said.

In June the academy, whose members choose the nominees and vote on the winners, announced tighter rules regarding potential conflicts of interest in response to claims that the selection process was open to rigging.

The Grammys will be handed out in Los Angeles on January 31, hosted by Trevor

Noah. British singer Dua Lipa, pop star Taylor Swift and rapper Roddy Ricch got six nominations apiece.

Swift and Dua Lipa will compete for the top prize - album of the year - along with R&B singer Post Malone, British band Coldplay, female band Haim, avant-garde Briton Jacob Collier, American soul band Black Pumas and American alternative R&B singer Jhene Aiko.

Billboard called the nominations for album, record, song of the year and best new artist surprising for the range of "superstar nominees as well as out-of-nowhere newcomers."


Bob Dylan, 79, was a no-show despite acclaim for his first album of new music in eight years, "Rough and Rowdy Ways," while established artists like Katy Perry, Maren Morris, The Chicks, Halsey and the Jonas Brothers all got zero nominations. But K-pop sensation BTS got its first major Grammy nod, for single "Dynamite" in the best pop group performance field, in a breakthrough for a South Korean group. The best new artist field included rappers Megan Thee Stallion and Doja Cat, as well as alternative artist Phoebe Bridgers and Noah Cyrus.

## Pandemic is a surprise boom for women in world's back office

THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC has hit women worldwide with job losses and closures of childcare centres. Yet a surprising bright spot is emerging: India's \$200 billion technology services industry, where new roles are expected to provide female workers with a broad swath of flexible work arrangements and fresh employment opportunities.

On the outskirts of New Delhi, Teena Likhari, 45, quit her job running operations for the Indian back office of a Silicon Valley company in 2018



because of a family medical emergency. Looking to rejoin this year, she expected a market stunted by lockdowns. Instead, the pandemic had made work-from-home mainstream in her industry, which had long shunned the practice.

Not only did the operations manager quickly land a job

with Indian outsourcer WNS Global Services, but working from her home in the city of Gurgaon, she began overseeing a 100-member team in the city of Pune about 900 miles away.

Likhari is one of the early beneficiaries of India's decision to lift decades-old restrictions on remote work in back office firms because of the pandemic.

The tech services industry - one of the country's most important financially -- can now allow employees to shift from traditional offices to work-from-anywhere arrangements, permanently if needed.

# In Pune, Fadnavis attacks Uddhav govt: 'Paltooram sarkar' makes many promises, then backtracks

DESCRIBING THE Uddhav Thackeray-led Maha Vikas Aghadi as "paltooram sarkar", former chief minister and opposition leader Devendra Fadnavis on Wednesday claimed that the state government has made several promises in the last one year, but has not lived up to a single one of them.

"This Maha Vikas Aghadi government is a paltooram sarkar as it has gone back on several promises it made to the people. In the last one year of its rule, it made several promises but failed to keep any of them," said Fadnavis at a party workers' rally, organised for the BJP candidate contesting the Pune graduates' and teachers' constituency polls for the Legislative Council, at the Ramkrishna More

auditorium in Chinchwad.

Fadnavis said that while Prime Minister Narendra Modi has been working in the interest of the poor during the Covid-19 pandemic, the Maharashtra government had failed to even extend help of "one paisa" to the people.

"Prime Minister Narendra Modi is a 'karmayogi'." During the Covid-19 challenge, he reached out to the common man, the poor, farmers and women. He tried to extend help to all sections of the society. On the other hand, the state government only indulges in empty talk and does nothing for the common man. Even small states have come up with packages for the poor, but the government of a most progressive state has not even extended a 'single paisa' help to the poor. The state government tells people to look after their own families while it is

looking after its own family," claimed the senior BJP leader.

Bringing up the issue of inflated power bills, Fadnavis said, "During corona time, even those who lived in a two-room tenement were handed Rs 30,000 monthly bills. After the BJP held agitations, the government promised to correct the bill and give a rebate. It became breaking news. However, the government went back on its word as the minister said the people will have to pay the bills and there would be no reduction in them. The minister said he will have to study the whole issue...I don't understand what he was doing all this while."

Fadnavis claimed that the MVA government was adept at making promises but does nothing when the time comes to fulfill them. "It first promised Rs 50,000 per hectare for crop loss to farmers,

then it said it will give Rs 25,000 per hectare. But till date, it has failed to give even one single paisa to the hapless farmers. Every day, it makes promises and then fails to live up to them," he said.

Fadnavis, who was Bihar poll in-charge for the BJP, said in the Assembly elections, people had voted for Prime Minister Narendra Modi's credibility. "Everyone thought the anti-incumbency factor will have a major role to play in Bihar. However, people in Bihar voted in the name of the Prime Minister because of his credibility. During corona time and even otherwise, the PM has relentlessly worked for the people, earning him high credibility among the masses. Not only in Bihar, but the party won across the country in all bypolls," he said.

A division bench of Justice S S Shinde and Justice M S Karnik heard the criminal application filed by Nisar Ahmed Haji Sayyed Bilal, the father of a man who died in the blast along with five others.

## Guinea national arrested with 2.9 kg of cocaine

OFFICIALS OF the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) intercepted and arrested a 34-year-old Republic of Guinea national for allegedly carrying 2.9 kg cocaine, worth Rs 18 crore, on Tuesday.

Officials said they received an input that the person, identified as Moussa Camara, was travelling from Addis Ababa to Mumbai via Dubai and had concealed a narcotic substance in his baggage.

"He was identified with the help of his passport at the arrival hall. He was carrying a trolley bag with a false bottom in which the package was concealed," said an officer. Camara was produced before court Wednesday and remanded to judicial custody till December 8. This is the third such seizure in the last 10 days.

## Three held for input tax credit fraud of over Rs 2,350 crore

THE DIRECTORATE General of GST Intelligence (DGGI) in Mumbai arrested three people on Wednesday in connection with an input tax credit (ITC) fraud of more than Rs 2,350 crore.

The accused, who were arrested in separate cases, include Sachin Bhoruka, director of firms such Erman Metals Pvt Ltd, Pioneer Trading Co, Marshal Multiventures (I) Pvt Ltd and Aiky Infraprojects Pvt Ltd, Mahesh Kinger, authorised signatory of Blue Sea Commodities Pvt Ltd and director of Theme Lights Pvt Ltd, and Deepak Kumar Prajapati, director of Udyog Kiran Ltd. Bhoruka, according to the probe agency, has availed and utilised fictitious ITC of Rs 485.64 crore and passed on fake ITC of another Rs 485.55 crore.

In the case of Kinger, the DGGI has alleged that his firms too availed, utilised and passed on "ineligible ITC on the basis of bogus invoices issued and received without any actual supply or receipt of any goods or services".

"The total quantum of the fraud committed involves Goods and Services Tax (GST) amounting to Rs 1,159.99 crore," said Seema Jere Bisht, principal additional director general, DGGI, Mumbai. In case of Prajapati, the DGGI has found that apart from allegedly indulging in GST fraud of Rs 220 crore, he had formed 22 companies for circular trading to artificially inflate the "turnover to avail higher bank loans and credit facilities".

The three have been booked under Section 69(1) of the Central Goods and Services Act, 2017 and have been remanded to judicial custody till December 7.

**FILM CULTURAL CENTRE FAILS TO TAKE OFF**

## BMC plans to take back children's theatre allotted for project from NFDC

FIVE YEARS after the proposed film cultural centre at Bandra West failed to take off, the BMC plans to take back a children's theatre, handed over for the project, from the National Film Development Corporation (NFDC).

Citing violation of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) signed between the BMC and NFDC, the civic body has said that the lease should be canceled and the theatre be handed over to some other organisation that can start the cultural centre.

On Wednesday, a proposal of canceling the MoU with NFDC and taking back the theatre was tabled before BMC's improvement committee for final ap-

IN 2014, BMC had cleared a proposal of handing over a children theatre to NFDC for 30 years on Re 1 annual rent. The theatre, located on Shery Rajan Road on Bandra West, was leased out to NFDC for developing a film cultural centre to promote Indian films and art. In 2015, NFDC and BMC inked a MoU for developing the centre. The theatre is spread over 712 sq m and finds mention in the city's Development Plan.

proval. After a brief discussion, the committee decided to visit the theatre before taking any decision.

The BMC has listed six breaches of MoU conditions. They include NFDC's failure to start the film cultural centre after renovating the existing children theatre, loss of revenue due to its non-functioning and NFDC not including the BMC representative in the advisory committee set up for the project.

According to the BMC, the cultural centre was proposed to have an exhibition hall, a digital cinema hall, a reading and research library and a book shop.

After NFDC failed to start the centre, in 2018, BJP leader and then minister Ashish Shelar had asked the BMC to take back the theatre. Following this, the BMC had initiated the process of canceling the MoU with NFDC.
