

## LABOUR PROTECTION LAWS

### Experts: Lack of implementation aggravating migrants' crisis

FROM MORTGAGING land to survive in the cities during the nationwide lockdown to walking thousands of kilometres to reach home state, it is the lack of implementation of various labour laws, meant to act as safeguards, that have aggravated difficulties of migrant workers stranded in different parts of the country, labour law experts and activists say.

The Interstate Migrant Workers Act, 1979, which has a provision for mandatory registration of interstate migrant workers, both at the home and host states, through contractors employing them, is one of the primary legislations on labourers employed outside their state. The Act also provides for displacement and journey allowances to be paid to the workers by their primary employers.

"The Act puts the onus on the state and the employer... If the employer cannot, then the state can provide assistance to the worker. But due to an absence of such data, the group has become invisible in the policy realm, leading to lack of initiative at the interstate level," Rahul Sapkal, assistant professor at School of Management and Labour Studies, Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS), Mumbai, said. If migrant workers had been registered as per the law, Sapkal added, they currently would not have to register for repatriation before the police or district officials.

So far, district heads across Maharashtra have received and are verifying details of over two lakh stranded workers, officials of the labour department said. Most of them are labourers who had started to walk to their home states but were stopped by the police and subsequently accommodated at relief camps.

In January 2017, a report of the Working Group on Migration, submitted by members of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Urban Development, Labour and Employment and NITI Aayog, had among its recommendations said that while workers do not migrate through contractors, "simple and effective modes for workers to register, including self-registration processes like SMS" could be put in place "... to ensure that the digitisation of registration records is leveraged to effectuate interstate probability of protection and benefits".

The report also commented on the state-level Construction Workers' Welfare Boards, which collect one to two per cent cess on construction projects, but that largely remains unutilised. The Standing Committee on Labour, 2017-18, report had found that Maharashtra utilised only 6.77 per cent of the cess amount.

According to the Commissioner of Labour, Mahendra Kalyankar, said the state board currently has Rs 9,000 crore cess amount.

"The money is being utilised for various welfare schemes, including mid-day meals for workers and to disburse Rs 2,000 for each registered construction worker," he said. So far, Kalyankar said, more than 5.10

lakh workers have received Rs 2,000. An official from the labour department said other welfare schemes, including for assistance in education for children, financial help and social security, will be implemented after the lockdown is lifted.

Experts, however, say this is far too little considering the crisis since the coronavirus-induced lockdown was imposed on March 25. "Rs 2,000 crore is insufficient. Workers should have been paid at least a month's minimum wages for three months. This sum is being paid to only those who have been registered. When there are several others whose registrations are pending or not done due to other issues. The deposited cess amount can include rights-based benefits to cover a lot more workers," said senior lawyer Gayatri Singh. Singh had represented a petition before the Bombay High Court seeking relief for workers.

Others say that the crisis also reflects on the inadequacy of labour protection legislations, including the Payment of Wages Act and the Contract Labour Act. "This has shown the inadequacy of our laws, where while there are provisions for wages to be paid in such a situation, workers were forced to return to their home states as they had no money."

The government issued notifications under the Disaster Management Act to state that wages should be paid to workers, but we have not heard of action being taken against any employer," said Sanjay Singhvi, senior advocate and general secretary of Trade Union Center of India.

Experts also said the number of labour officers in the state is disproportionate to the units and workers.

An official from the labour department said there are 140 labour officers currently in the state, with more than 50 per cent vacancies on all its posts.

Joint Commissioner of Labour, Raviraj Ilwe, said since March 29, a total of 393 complaints for non-payment of wages and termination of work have been received, of which 295 were disposed of.

"We have received complaints, notices have also been issued. In many cases, we are persuading employers that it is in the interest of their businesses to ensure that workers are paid. Penal action under the Disaster Management Act can be taken further, if necessary," Ilwe said.

## 23,000 cops above 50 given low-risk work, says Deshmukh

12,000 policemen above 55 asked to stay at home

AS A precautionary measure amid the pandemic, nearly 23,000 Maharashtra police personnel, aged between 50 to 55 years, are being given low-risk police station tasks, while 12,000, who are above 55, have been asked to stay home, Maharashtra Home Minister Anil Deshmukh said on Tuesday.

The number of Covid-19 cases among the 2.2 lakh-strong Maharashtra Police force had, by Monday, crossed 1,000.

Officials have said a majority of cases from Maharashtra Police are among local police personnel from Mumbai, Thane, Malegaon, or personnel of the State Reserve Police Force (SRPF) who were deployed in these high-risk areas.

"We are also seeing rapid growth in numbers due to aggressive testing and many are asymptomatic. Seven police personnel have died due to Covid-19 till date, which include four from Mumbai and one each from Pune, Solapur

### PM clears Rs 2 lakh ex-gratia for next of kin

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi has approved an ex-gratia of Rs 2 lakh each to the next of kin of the 16 migrant labourers killed after being run over by a goods train on May 8 near Aurangabad, Maharashtra. Those who were seriously injured in the incident will be given Rs 50,000 each. The compensation will be given from the PM National Relief Fund, sources said on Tuesday.

The 16 migrants were walking home along the track and had stopped to take rest. According to initial investigations, they had apparently drifted off to sleep

Rural and Nashik police," said a police official.

Speaking to The Indian Express, Deshmukh said on Tuesday, "Our police personnel are fighting the battle against Covid-19 from the frontline. Many of them are deployed at quarantine and isolation facilities, hospitals or at check points in highly-affected areas. They are being provided with adequate safety gear and utilities. A dedicated Covid helpline has been created for police personnel. Dedicated isolation, quarantine facilities and hospitals have been earmarked at some places."

"However, to reduce the risk due to age-related factors, as many as 23,000 police personnel in the

50-55 age group are being given low-risk police station duties. And 12,000 above 55 years of age have been asked to stay home till further notice. These directions have been issued to police units across the state. Health preconditions, if any, are also being taken into consideration. Seven police personnel have till now lost their lives. Their families will be given ex-gratia amount of Rs 50 lakh plus Rs 10 lakh from police family welfare fund and Rs 5 lakh from group insurance scheme. One of their family members will be given a government job," he said.

The home minister added, "While the police have to do these difficult duties, there have been 212 instances of attacks on policemen, for which we have arrested 750 persons till now. Police have also done a great deal of humanitarian relief work in providing ration, food and safety utilities to people who are in need. I want to assure the police force that the entire state is standing behind them as they protect us."

## Crimes during lockdown: no chain snatching, dacoity

IT IS a statistic that would have made any Mumbai Police commissioner proud had the circumstances been normal. In April, the 94 police stations across Mumbai did not report a single case of chain snatching, which has perennially been a headache for the police. While police action in the last few years had brought down the number of chain snatching cases considerably, it took Covid-19 pandemic and the resultant lockdown to stop the crime altogether.

Another type of crime that has drawn a blank since the lockdown is dacoity — where five or more persons commit a robbery — not a single case has been reported so far.

While the latter half of March was spent under lockdown, the city spent April entirely under prohibitory orders. The statistics show that in April, eight murders were reported in the city, including two double murders in Govandi. Both the murders — in Sewri and Govandi — were the result of petty domestic squabbles between two groups residing in the same locality.

While the Sewri murders took place as the family of the deceased would sit in front of the victims' house chawl, in the Govandi case, the deceased were killed over putting up a water dispensing kiosk.

An officer from Govandi police station said, "With everyone at home in chawls and houses not big enough to accommodate them, many stay outside. This has led to several fights among local residents over petty issues."

There were 17 robberies in April as compared to 80 in February. As against a robbery (where the accused causes or attempts to hurt a victim), theft cases (no such harm is involved) dropped to 34 in April from 483 cases in February.

"Usually, theft cases take place where thieves take advantage of the crowd to flee with victim's bag or phone. The absence of crowd explains the numbers going down," a crime branch officer said. Further, statistics show that 66 break-ins were reported in April, while the corresponding figure in February was 142. Several such cases involved burglars taking advantage of liquor and jewellery shops being shut with no security personnel on guard. Break-ins were also reported at liquor and grocery shops — even amul butter was stolen.

Shops that have valuables but are shut is a major area of concern. An officer from south Mumbai said that in areas like Zaveri Bazaar, they have ensured that police patrolling is more frequent, especially at night.

A total of 84 motor vehicle thefts

were recorded in April as compared to 202 in February. "We have had several cases of autorickshaws, bikes and cycles being stolen. Many of these vehicles were parked on the road and with no one to look after them, they became an easy target," an officer said.

When it came to crime against women, statistics show that 89 cases were registered in April as compared to 559 in February. Of the cases registered in April, 17 were rape cases with 12 of the victims being minors.

Moreover, 36 cases of outraging the modesty of women, nine cases of intentionally insulting the modesty of women, four cases of dowry related physical and mental harassment and one case of harassment leading to suicide were reported in April.

Nandini Sardesai, former head of sociology department, St Xavier's College, said: "A lot of angst is building up among people, leading to domestic violence as well as child and elderly abuse. People are anxious and they are looking for someone to vent their frustration... Those around — like family members and neighbours will bear the brunt."

She added, "The lockdown will leave social scars, like children being witnesses to domestic abuse."

# Crude oil prices to stabilise over next 4-6 quarters: Icra

**CRUDE OIL CRASH** is creating several headwinds for both upstream and downstream companies, a report said expecting prices to stabilise over the next four to six quarters given the shape of the global economy.

While the global economy is projected to contract 3% this year, the domestic economy is forecast to stall completely, though may stave off contraction, according to many analysts. India, the third largest fuel consumer and importer, is under a seven-week Covid-19 lockdown ending on May 17, has seen demand almost halving during the national shuttering, while the global demand crimped by 30% in April, when almost the whole world was under lockdowns.

The prices fell also because crude has been in substantial oversupply since February.

According to an analysis by domestic rating agency Icra, Brent crude is likely to trade in the range of \$20 to \$40 a barrel in the medium term or till the Covid-19 infections abate, as the world is fearing a second wave of the pandemic from next winter.

"Brent may trade in a band of \$20 to \$40 a barrel until the Covid-19 fears abate, with intermittent volatility depending on news flow," Icra told a webinar on Tuesday.

The plunge in global crude prices — down from \$77 a barrel early January to mid-\$20s now — is highly credit negative

for domestic upstream players, while refining and marketing companies and gas utilities also face several headwinds.

Profitability of the downstream sector will also be impacted by lower gross refining margins (GRMs) as the pandemic has eroded demand for refined fuel thereby weighing on crack spreads with gasoline and ATF spreads being the worst hit.

While ATF demand fell 94% in April, petrol intake plunged 64%, forcing refineries to run at around 40% of their capacity as the lockdown has stopped all traffic.

According to K Ravichandran, a senior vice-president at Icra, the sharp drop in crude prices is credit negative for the upstream sector as their realisations and cash accruals will decline meaningfully. Additionally, gas prices at various international gas hubs have declined, which will lead to lower domestic gas prices in FY21.

# India's largest ceramic cluster resumes ops

**INDIA'S LARGEST CLUSTER** of ceramics industry in Morbi is gradually recommencing production activities following the Gujarat government's permission to resume business activities in the green zones since the beginning of May.

Over the past one week, 70-80 of the 1,000-odd units have recommenced production works, said Nilesh Jetpariya, president of Morbi Ceramic Association, adding that right from the implementation of the nationwide lockdown, Morbi and surrounding areas had remained in green zone.

Despite the government's permission, it would take at least a couple of months to start all the units normally as nearly 50% of migrant labourers have moved back to their home states. As the government started special trains to Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Odisha from Gujarat, nearly 50,000 labourers employed in the ceramic industry decided to go back, said Jetpariya.

According to him another 20,000 labourers wanted to return to their native places.

The ceramic cluster at Morbi is providing employment to over 1 lakh people directly and nearly 2 lakh others indirectly.

The ceramic association has record of only those workers who are directly employed with the units, he said. If those indirectly employed are counted, the number of labourers who have returned to their native places could be much higher.

With Morbi ceramic industry gradually restarting to function, Gujarat Gas (GGL) has also started witnessing surge in natural gas demand. The Gujarat government-owned company is selling nearly 80% of natural gas to Morbi ceramic cluster. Since March 25, demand from

the cluster had suddenly plummeted from as high as 6.5-7.0 million standard cubic metre a day (mscmd) to almost zero. However, with recommencement of work at Morbi, demand has again gone up to around 0.7 mscmd.

Apart from the ceramic cluster in Morbi, GGL is supplying gas to household and industrial consumers in South Gujarat.

The company continued supply to household during entire lockdown period. Relaxation in lockdown has increased gas demand from industrial customers also, said an official of GGL.

According to him overall natural gas sales for Gujarat Gas had been doubled from nearly 1.0 mscmd in the beginning of May to over 2.0 mscmd at present. Gujarat Gas has a network of over 24,000 km of gas pipeline, 395 LNG stations, connections to 15 lakh households and 4,390 industrial and commercial establishments as its consumers. It distributes about 9.3 mscmd of natural gas, of which 80% is consumed by Morbi ceramic cluster.

# India's carbon emissions fall for first time in four decades

**INDIA'S CARBON DIOXIDE** emissions fell for the first time in four decades as a combination of economic weakness and competition from renewable power limited consumption of fossil fuels.

Emissions likely dropped by 1.4% in the year ended March, thanks to slowing demand for coal and oil over the previous 12 months, Centre for Research on Energy and Clean Air analysts Lauri Myllyvirta and Sunil Dahiyia said in a report on Tuesday. Carbon dioxide releases plunged 15% in March and 30% in April from a year earlier, as a countrywide lockdown to



halt the spread of the coronavirus further eroded fuel demand, the report said.

The pandemic could influence long-term energy planning in a country that's the world's third-largest emitter of carbon dioxide and heavily reliant on coal to drive its economic growth. Weeks of lockdown have eased India's chronic air pollution, raising hopes of a more sustainable solution.

With dipping prices of clean energy, a shift in the country's energy mix is already emerging. India's coal-fired generation fleet had an average utilisation of 56% in the 12 months through March, the lowest in at least 15 years, power ministry data show. "Any return of India's poor air quality and smog can be expected to trigger a stronger response," Myllyvirta and Dahiyia wrote in the report. —BLOOMBERG

# Indian LPG reversal shows peril of buying fuel in pandemic



**INDIA HAS CANCELLED** orders for multiple cargoes of liquefied petroleum gas just weeks after going on a buying spree as the nation went into lockdown, highlighting the difficulty of assessing fuel demand in a pandemic.

The nation's three biggest state-owned refiners have negotiated the cancellation of at least five cargoes of the fuel due to arrive in May and June with term suppliers in the Middle East, according to traders and company officials. The processors were left with too much LPG after over-estimating demand and ramping up purchases in late March and early April.

Consumption of transport and industrial fuels plunged after India imposed the world's biggest national lockdown on March 25, but LPG was resilient as it's mainly used for cooking at home. Demand for the gas, the only processed fuel that India imports large quantities of, was estimated to have jumped 40% in the first week of April as people rushed to stock up. The buying tempo wasn't sustained, however, with consumption increasing only 12% over the full month.

The Indian refiners' predicament shows how difficult it is to assess demand in the midst of a fast-evolving pandemic. The country's initial three-week stay-home order has already been extended twice but has also been relaxed with factories, offices and transportation restarting gradually. The government's announcement in late March



that it would supply LPG free to 83 million poor households may also have skewed the refiners' buying decisions.

"Panic buying in India last month somewhat boosted demand and thus imports of LPG," said Jeslyn Chua, an analyst at industry consultant FGE. "Despite India extending the lockdown until May 17, it's not going to boost LPG demand as Indians have already covered their needs for May and June."

The five LPG shipments of around 45,000 tonne each bought by Indian Oil, Bharat Petroleum and Hindustan Petroleum have been cancelled through mutual agreements with the suppliers, according to the traders and officials who didn't want to be named due to internal company policy. The Indian companies typically import 25-30 cargoes a month through long-term contracts with producers including Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Oman and Kuwait.

Spokespeople at the three refiners didn't respond to emails seeking comment. The processors went on a buying spree just after the lockdown was announced, with oil minister Dharmendra Pradhan even asking the Saudis to ensure there was

enough supply for India as local processors implemented production cuts. They issued tenders to buy at least 7,37,000 tonne of LPG for delivery in April, May and June, normally the leanest months for consumption of the gas, but ended up purchasing just over half that amount as prices skyrocketed. —BLOOMBERG
