

Royal Enfield to recall 15,200 units of 3 models sold abroad

ICONIC BIKE MAKER Royal Enfield on Wednesday said it has decided to recall 15,200 units of the Interceptor 650, Continental GT 650 and Himalayan motorcycles sold abroad, due to a corrosion-related issue. The company said it had discovered a brake caliper corrosion-related issue in a small number of motorcycles in some specific countries. Upon investigation, it was revealed that this corrosion is brought about by sustained, long-term exposure to riding on roads treated with certain salts, or a combination of salts, to prevent formation of ice during winters. This corrosion causes damage to the brake caliper piston bore and assemblies, and can result in unusual braking sound, increased brake drag, and may

impact braking action, a statement said. While the issue has been reported only in a small number of cases, Royal Enfield has decided to undertake a proactive, safety-related service action of the Interceptor 650, Continental GT 650 and Himalayan motorcycles sold across geographies.—**FE BUREAU**

CHAHAL TO WARD OFFICERS

'Lodge FIRs against pvt hospitals that have not reopened despite orders'

MUMBAI, MAY 20

MUNICIPAL COMMISSIONER I S Chahal on Wednesday ordered ward officers to register a criminal offence against private hospitals, clinics and nursing homes that have failed to reopen even after repeated orders by the civic body. Anticipating a spike in the number of coronavirus cases, Chahal also directed ward officers to reserve 100 beds each from nursing homes and small private hospitals in their respective wards. "Out of 100 beds, at least 10 per cent must be ICU (intensive care unit) beds," Chahal said.

In a video meeting with the 24 ward officers, Chahal asked the officials to ensure that all private hospitals and nursing homes were reopened. Chahal has asked all the ward officers to prepare a list of such hospitals and clinics, which have closed down in the last two months, and register a criminal offence against them.

After reports that a large number of patients, with coronavirus symptoms as well as other illnesses, are being made to run from one hospital to another for admission, the civic body had directed all the private hospitals to open their out-patient depart-

ments (OPDs), nursing home and clinics. Even after repeated reminders and notices from the civic body, many private hospitals and nursing homes in the city chose to remain shut. The civic body had directed all hospitals to start providing medical services as non-Covid patients were facing problems in accessing healthcare.

Several hospitals had reached out to the BMC claiming that they were unable to run routine services of OPD and admissions due to staff shortage. With a spurt in Covid-19 cases, especially among medical practitioners, many have shut down.

In the meeting, Chahal asked

civic officials to ensure supply of personal protective equipment (PPE) kits to private hospitals. According to the circular dated May 14, the BMC will help private clinics in and near containment zones with PPE kits to facilitate screening of those displaying Covid-19 symptoms.

In the last month, several private hospitals had to be declared containment zones after their staff contracted the infection from unsuspecting patients. Jaslok, Shushruta, Breach Candy, Wockhardt, Bhatia, Hinduja Khar and Sai (Chembur) hospitals had to be sealed and staff had to be quarantined.

Traffic snarls make a comeback on city roads

MAXIMUM CITY remains in the red zone but the now two-month-long lockdown, which entered its fourth phase on May 18, is clearly fraying, with traffic on the roads the main indicator of this. There are more vehicles on the roads than at any time since March 22, when the city shut down two days ahead of the national lockdown.

There are even traffic snarls on the highways and major roads across the city but largely on account of the police checkpoints on various roads. Armed with the knowledge of where the checkpoints are, several, including cab drivers, have found a way to ply their trade without landing in trouble.

Tilak Singh, a cab driver, had parked his kaali-peeli on one side of LJ Road in Mahim. When asked if the cab, which is not officially allowed to ply, was ready for hire, he replied in the affirmative. "I only take fares for

south Mumbai, I do not go towards the suburbs. I know there is a police nakabandi on the road ahead so I take a few bylanes to circumvent the nakabandis," Singh told The Indian Express.

"I do get fares through the day. I'm charging by the meter as I know everyone is in a desperate situation. I too have been in the city for too long to go back to my village," Singh said, before driving off as he got a fare for Shivaji park. Like him, several auto and cab drivers were seen plying on internal roads of local areas, like in Andheri, which they know is not manned by police.

On the highways and major roads, however, the story is different. BEST buses plying migrants to railway stations, ambulances, essential services vehicles, delivery executives, JCB

and dumpers dotted the Western Express Highway (WEH) on Wednesday evening. There were traffic snarls on the WEH in Vile Parle, on LJ Road near Machchimar Colony at Mahim and Worli naka due to police checkpoints. "The traffic is on account of the checkpoints but these are needed or else everyone will be on the road," a traffic official said.

"Since past week, vehicles on the roads have gone up. Most vehicular traffic is in the morning hours," said a traffic constable at a checkpoint on the WEH. "We allow vehicles with emergency services sticker. In other cases, they show us ID cards. In addition, there are several vehicles carrying migrants out of the city," he added.

"In many cases, rumour-mongering has also led to peo-

ple coming out on the roads. Many people show us WhatsApp messages claiming vehicular movement has been allowed. The messages are either false or misinterpreted by people," said Raju Gaikwad, a traffic constable at a checkpoint on Cadell Road near Shivaji Park. "In some cases, people don't have police passes but show us some medical slip. How can we allow them unless there is an emergency? We ask them to approach local police for permission," he added.

Apart from this, there are youngsters on bikes. "They see police nakabandi from a distance, try to take a U-turn and flee. If we nab them, a case is registered and the vehicle impounded. They then have to figure out a way to return home by themselves," he said.

57-year-old BMC security officer dies

A 57-YEAR-OLD security officer of the civic body, who was due to retire later this year, Wednesday succumbed to the novel coronavirus, the ninth Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) staffer to die due to the infection. So far, 80 civic security personnel have tested positive for the virus, of whom 55 are still undergoing treatment and 25 have recovered.

The security guard, originally posted at KEM hospital at Parel, was last month shifted to G-South ward — comprising Worli, Mahalaxmi, Lower Parel — after a government directive restricted assigning staff above 55 years on Covid-19 duty.

"On May 14, the security officer, a resident of Delisle Road in Lower Parel, was admitted to KEM Hospital after he complained of breathlessness. Subsequently, his sample was tested for Covid-19. On Tuesday, after he tested positive and was shifted to a Covid-19 ward. By evening, his condition deteriorated and he died early Wednesday morning," an official from BMC's security guard department said.

The official added that the source of his infection is yet to be ascertained.

Of 55 security personnel, who are undergoing treatment for the virus, 52 are guards and three others are officers.

BMC employs 2,400 security

Of the 55 security staffers, who are undergoing treatment for the virus, 52 are guards and 3 are officers

guards, who are deployed at civic hospitals, ward offices, and other central offices. The corporation also has more than 2,200 private security personnel.

The BMC employees' union has alleged that the security staff is not being given proper safety equipment, which is exposing them to infection. "The security guards are not getting enough safety equipment. They get poor quality masks and gloves. The civic body should give them PPE kits when they are deployed at Covid-19 wards. The 57-year-old security officer was assigned on duty even when he was above 55 years of age. This is complete negligence," Prakash Devdas of Mumbai Manpa Karmchari Sangathana said.

The civic administration has denied the allegations.

"We are giving all the safety equipment to our staff. If any guard is posted at a Covid-19 ward, he is being given PPE. Apart from this, all guards have been given masks, gloves, and hand sanitiser. We have enough stock. Also, all our staff is covered under the compensation policy of Covid-19 death," said a senior officer of the civic body's security department. Chief security officer, Vinod Badkar, could not be reached for comment.

2 constables die, toll 10

TWO MUMBAI Police constables succumbed to Covid-19 on Wednesday, taking the overall toll for the city police force to 10.

The police identified the constables as Ganesh Chaudhary from Parkside police station and Dhivsen Pingale from the traffic department.

ACP (Vikhroli division) Vilas Kanade said, "Ganesh Chaudhary had been on leave for the last 10 days. After he started suffering from fever and breathlessness, he underwent a Covid-19 test, which confirmed that he was infected." Chaudhary was admitted at Seven Hills hospital eight days ago. "As he was also suffering from diabetes, his immunity system could not fight the virus," said an officer.

Pingale, who was posted at the traffic department, developed symptoms on May 6, following which he underwent a test. "After he tested positive, he was admitted to Trauma Care hospital in Jogeshwari," said an officer. On May 10, he was shifted to Seven Hills hospital, where he died.

So far, 699 Mumbai police personnel have tested positive, with 93 of them recovering. Besides the 10 in Mumbai Police, 14 personnel from the state police have succumbed to the virus.

A while later, as the policemen refused to budge, he again tweeted saying, "Even as other of-

ficers have understood the situation and are sympathetic, the OIC, Vijay K Kadam at Jogeshwari highway police chowki decided to file an FIR and impound my car. This is plain harassment."

However, traffic authorities said the allegations were false. Kadam said, "He has been lying all this while. His house help's wife delivered a baby on May 14. There were two persons present in the car, one was his driver while another was his house help. There was no woman in the car, and he was also not present in the vehicle."

Activist drives six migrants workers to Ghatkopar, threatened with FIR by police

ENVIRONMENT ACTIVIST and lawyer Afrooz Shah alleged on Wednesday that he was detained by the police on Tuesday night when he was ferrying migrant workers walking towards Ghatkopar to take a bus to Uttar Pradesh.

Shah claimed he was taken to the Tilak Nagar police station and threatened with an FIR and a traffic challan for violating lockdown norms. Since March 18, Shah said he had been providing food and ration to people. "I have also been travelling on the Mumbai-Nashik highway, where many workers are walking, to provide them food," he added.

"While I was returning from there on Tuesday night along with a volunteer, we saw a group of six workers who wanted to go to Ghatkopar," Shah said. He added

he decided to drop them to the suburb but was stopped at a checkpoint in Ghatkopar. "The policemen on duty spoke rudely and behaved in a high-handed manner. I told them I had permission," Shah said.

He added he was taken to the police station for registration of an FIR, but after 45 minutes, was again taken to the spot, where a traffic constable said a challan would be issued against him. "Finally, after two hours, I was asked to go. I have now decided to suspend all my activities," he said.

Senior Inspector of Tilak Nagar police station said since Shah didn't have the necessary paperwork to drive migrants, he was taken to the police station. "Initially, he was told an FIR would be registered against him. But then we realised that his intention was not wrong and allowed him to leave. No offence was registered against him." Kamble denied that any policeman behaved rudely with Shah.

Concern as BMC set to resume biometric attendance at hospitals

THE BMC's decision to resume biometric attendance at civic and government hospitals to check absenteeism has caused concern as fingerprint identification machines, touched by hundreds of employees, could become a potential coronavirus spreader.

A May 16 circular, signed by Directorate of Medical Education and Research (DMER) Dr T P Lahane and Municipal Commissioner I S Chahal, states that biometric attendance in the government, as well as the civic hospitals for medical, non-medical, and para-medical staff, should be resumed as soon as possible. It further states that due care should be taken to wash

hands with soap and water or sanitiser to prevent transmission of the novel coronavirus disease.

Civic hospitals had suspended biometric attendance on March 16 soon after the outbreak of the pandemic. On Wednesday, civic officials said the decision to recommence the biometric attendance system was taken in view of the irregular staff attendance.

"Biometric machines will help keep a record of employees, and rotation of duties can be ra-

tionalised to ease the pressure on staff working consistently for the last two months," the official said.

However, officials also expressed concern that the machines themselves could pose a risk — first, its touch mechanism, and second, the queues of staffers waiting to mark attendance that it may trigger.

"The central government had cancelled biometric attendance system and there is no biometric presence in reputed hospitals, like AIIMS. I would request the Maharashtra government not to play with the lives of medical officers and staffers," RTI activist Anil Galgali said.

Joint Municipal Commissioner, General Administration department, Milind Sawant, was not available for comment.

Distribute seized protective equipment to those on Covid-19 duty: HC to govt

THE BOMBAY High Court on Tuesday directed the state government to take all possible measures to implement orders by the competent authority and distribute essential protective equipment seized by investigating agencies in Maharashtra among those on Covid-19 duty.

The court passed an order af-

ter the state on Tuesday informed it that the competent authority under the Essential Commodities Act has already ordered the release of some vital protective equipment seized by investigating agencies to the BMC, which can be reached to the frontline workers.

Following this, the court disposed of a PIL filed by state Congress general secretary Mohan Joshi, seeking release of personal protective equipment,

hand sanitizers and masks seized by state agencies for use by hospitals and healthcare workers.

"So long the orders of competent authority are not disturbed in judicial proceedings, the state shall make all possible endeavour to implement such orders and ensure that in these trying times, the seized properties do reach the end-users for combating Covid-19," the court said.

स्थलांतरीतांसाठी टाण्यातून एसटी सुटतात याची माहिती पसरल्याने मुंबईच्या कानाकोपऱ्यातून लोढे टाण्याकडे येऊ लागले आहेत. मुंबई ते ठाणे प्रवासासाठी खासगी वाहने अवाच्या सवा पैसे आकारत आहेत. एका २५ जणांच्या समूहाने वांद्रे येथून टेंगोने ठाणे गाठण्यासाठी पाच हजार रुपये मोजले. तर कफ परेड ते ठाणे अशी तीन जणांच्या टॅक्सीसाठी १५०० रुपये द्यावे लागले. इतके पैसे मोजून देखील अनेकांना मुंबईच्या वेशीवरच सोडले जाते आणि पुढील प्रवास पायी करावा लागतो. त्यामुळे मुंबईतूनच एसटी बसगाड्या सोडण्याची मागणी या स्थलांतरितांनी केली.

स्थलांतरितांना राज्याच्या सीमेपर्यंत मोफत सोडण्याची सुविधा सुरू केल्यानेतर इतर वाहनांचा प्रवास कमी झाला. मुंबई आणि महानगर परिसरातील सर्व स्थलांतरीतांना ठाणे ते भिवंडी चाय पास या टप्प्यात एसटीचे ११ सुविधा थांबे तयार करण्यात आले. एसटीच्या सुविधेचा लाभ घेण्यासाठी मुंबई शहर, उपनगराच्या कानाकोपऱ्यातून स्थलांतरीत टाण्यात येत असल्याने शहरातील माजिवडा नाक्याला

ठाणे - उज्जाव प्रवास मोफत
एसटीने राज्याच्या सीमेपर्यंत सुविधा सुरू केल्यानंतर पुढील टप्प्यातील प्रवासाच्या सुविधा सुरवातीच्या काळात पुरेशा प्रमाणात उपलब्ध नव्हत्या. मात्र गेल्या आठवड्याभरात या सुविधा व्यवस्थित उपलब्ध झाल्या असून श्रीराम रावत या प्रवाशाने १५ मे रोजी टाण्यातून सुरू केलेला प्रवास १७ मे रोजी उज्जाव येथे पूर्ण झाला. मह्यप्रदेश आणि उत्तरप्रदेश राज्यांच्या सीमेवर प्रचंड वाढी असल्याने त्या ठिकाणी बसगाडी उपलब्ध होण्यास लागणार वेळ वाळता प्रवासात कोणताही अडथळा आला नसल्याचे त्यांनी सांगितले. सर्व राज्यात जेवणखाण्याची सुविधा स्वयंसेवी माध्यमातून होत असल्याने या संपूर्ण प्रवासात त्यांना कसलाही खर्च करावयाची गरजच पडली नाही.
