## Transfer of inspector Daya Nayak outside Mumbai stayed

TERMINING A 2013 letter that formed the basis of the transfer of Daya Nayak outside Mumbai "old and stale", the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (MAT) on Wednesday stayed the transfer of the police inspector to Gonda district where he was supposed to join the District Caste Scrutiny Committee (DSCS).

In a series of orders recently, the acting Director General of Police (DGP), Sanjay Pandey, had posted Nayak and six other high-profile officers out of Mumbai and Thane.

Sources said the other six may also approach MAT soon. Nayak, meanwhile, will remain in Mumbai, appearing for Nayak, asking that there was no case made out for

In a series of orders recently, the acting Director General of Police (DGP), Sanjay Pandey, had posted Nayak and six other high-profile officers out of Mumbai and Thane.

Hearing Nayak's plea, Judicial Member AP Kurbekar observed that Nayak had been transferred based on a 2013 letter that had been written by then Mumbai Police Commissioner. In the letter addressed to the DGP, the Commissioner had sought that based on certain allegations against him, Nayak should be transferred out of the city. Advocate Mahant Nagral, appearing for Nayak, asked that there was no case made out for

the mid-term transfer of his client. He further pointed out that during Nayak's promotion, he was allotted the Konkarn Division while the DGP's order transferred him to another division.

In addition, Lonkar said that in 2014, when Nayak was transferred to Nagpur, the government had accepted his contention that there was a threat to his life due to the cases he had registered against the underworld.

Calling the 2013 letter written by the Commissioner that formed the basis of the transfer "old and stale", MAT observed that there was no new material based on which the transfer was done. MAT also granted Nayak the benefit of a recent GR (government resolution) issued by the state government issuing directions to not affect any mid-term transfers till June.

# Mumbai Police has refused to conduct inquiry against Waze in Khwaja Yunus case

THE MUMBAI Police had on Tuesday ordered the dismissal of assistant inspector Sachin Waze without conducting any departmental inquiry while relying on Article 311 of the Constitution. In sharp contrast, the refusal to conduct an inquiry by the police was one of the grounds that had paved the way for Waze's reinstatement in the force last year after he was suspended for 16 years in connection to the Khwaja Yunus custodial death case.

Waze - an accused in the Ambani terror scare and Manshuk Hirani murder cases - was first suspended from the force along with three constables in 2004 following an order by the Bombay High Court.

Along with the suspension, the court had ordered that an inquiry be conducted against the four policemen.

For 16 years when the four remained suspended, no inquiry was conducted. On June 5, last

year, they were reinstated in the Mumbai Police following a decision taken by a committee headed by the police commissioner.

Yunus' mother Aisiya Begum had approached the HC last year stating that the Mumbai Police could not have reinstated Waze and the three other policemen as no inquiry was conducted against them despite the court's orders.

The police told the court that it had decided not to conduct an inquiry based on a rule in the police manual that it would be "practical" to wait for the final outcome of the criminal case they were booked for. The reply added that in 2006, a detailed note was prepared by a senior officer of the Mumbai police stating that there was no point of such an inquiry since the criminal case is underway and would

contravene the legal provisions. The Mumbai Police had then opposed Begum's petition, which had sought that the four be suspended again.

On Tuesday, Mumbai Police Commissioner Mahant Nagral relied on Article 311 of the Constitution to dismiss Waze, relying on his alleged involvement in the Ambani terror scare case, which is sub-judice too.

According to Article 311, no person who is a member of a civil service or holds a civil post can be dismissed or removed by an authority subordinate to that by which he was appointed. There are exceptions to these safeguards, which were used as ground to dismiss Waze.

Nagral's order makes no mention of the pending Yunus case. It also said that a regular inquiry will not be "reasonably practicable".

## CID records statement of Sonu Jalan

## NMMC, CIDCO join hands for work on Palm Beach road extension

THE NAVI Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) and CIDCO will undertake the extension of Palm Beach road from Ghansoli to Airoli, jointly bearing the cost of the Rs 250 cr project.

The extension work on the stretch measuring 1.94 km will be carried out by constructing roads and bridges and is expected to improve the connectivity of Ghansoli and Airoli node apart from reducing traffic snarls for commuters.

"The extension of Palm Beach road from Ghansoli to Airoli is likely to reduce traffic congestion for commuters travelling from CBD Belapur to Mumbai or Thane. With an aim to stimulate this project, CIDCO has decided to assist NMMC by contributing partly the cost of the project," said Dr Sanjay Mukherjee, vice chairman and Managing Director of CIDCO.

According to CIDCO, it had planned the 21.2-km Palm Beach road to Airoli in 2004. It has, so far, managed to complete a 19.20 km stretch from CBD Belapur to Ghansoli. Work on the 1.94-km stretch between Vashi and Airoli is yet to be completed.

CIDCO has clarified that it will not contribute any amount over Rs 125 crore for the work, adding that if the cost of the project increases, the civic body will be responsible for the preparation of a thorough project report and obtaining of necessary approvals. The amount will be transferred only after completion of the project, it added.
