BJP MLC arrested for giving bandh call that 'led to violence' in Amravati

Day 6 of curfew; local traders' associations say they are losing out on business worth crores daily

THE AMRAVATI City Police on Wednesday arrested Pravin Pote Patil, former BJP minister and MLC, who had given a bandh call last Saturday in Amravati city and was seen urging people to assemble at Rajkamal Chowk, from where the violence had started.

Patil was produced before a magistrate court later in the day and granted bail.

Patil has been the former state minister for industries and mining, environment. He was also the former guardian minister of Amravati and is presently a member of the Legislative Council.

On Tuesday, five more BJP leaders, including three sitting members of the Maharashtra Legislative Council, were arrested for violence in the bandh. In all, 240 people have been arrested so far on the violence.

As Amravati enters its sixth day of curfew, the local traders' associations on Wednesday said they are losing out on business worth crores daily.

Vijay Bhutada, president of Busland and Vyapari Samajik Association, said, "We in Amravati Police not allowing us to do our business? We are situated 12 km away from the city. Busland market, along with Cylind and Dreamland markets, have over 700 shops and retail shops. For five days

Need policy to compensate traders for losses suffered in communal strife: Pawar

NCP CHIEF Sharad Pawar on Wednesday said the state government should introduce a policy to compensate traders and entrepreneurs who suffer losses during incidents of communal strife.

Addressing a gathering of traders and entrepreneurs in Nagpur on Wednesday, Pawar said, "It is very unfortunate that the state witnessed reactions to what happened in Tripura. Some political parties poured out on the streets, which was wrong. Traders and entrepreneurs suffer heavy losses during such incidents for no fault of theirs. As such, the government should have a policy to compensate them in the event of such incidents."

Pawar at a four-day visit to Vidarbha, during which he will visit Gadchiroli, Chandrapur, Yavatmal and Wardha districts. The NCP chief said his tour was to expand his party's presence in the region. He also suggested that there should be a central committee with representatives from various organisations of

traders and entrepreneurs, which could look into the issues they face. "Traders and entrepreneurs from different parts of the state have different problems. So, to resolve their issues, there should be a central committee, which will be recognised by the government. This will help their problems reach the departments concerned. Such a committee will hold regular monthly meetings with the government. Such a policy needs to be formulated."

On whether the opposition was willing to accept West Bengal Chief Minister Manohar Parrikar's leadership in the fight against BJP in the 2024 elections, Pawar said, "Leadership is not the issue. We will discuss about a possible alliance in the upcoming Parliament session. Today, there is need to give options to people and we have to try to fulfill their wish."

Rahul moves HC seeking to quash defamation case

CONGRESS LEADER Rahul Gandhi has approached the Bombay High Court on November 12 challenging the 2019 order of the Girgaon magistrate court that had summoned him to appear in person in connection to a defamation complaint filed by Mahesh Hukumbhakar Shrinimal, purportedly a member of BJP.

Justice Sandeep K Shinde is hearing Gandhi's plea against the initiation of criminal proceedings by Girgaon magistrate on August 28, 2019. Shrinimal had alleged that in September, 2018, at a rally in Rajasthan, Gandhi had made a defamatory statement against Prime Minister Narendra Modi, due to which the PM was trolled by various news channels and on social media platforms. As per the complaint, four days after the rally, Gandhi purportedly tweeted about a video, saying - "The sad truth about

India's commander in chief". It was the attorney general who made "direct allegation of theft against BJP members and Indian citizens connected to Modi", the complaint stated. The writ plea filed by Gandhi through advocate Kishal Mor said that the complaint was "frivolous and vexatious", motivated by the "sole purpose of complainant's latent political agenda". Gandhi said that he became

aware of the magistrate order after he received summons on court on July 12, this year. Maintaining that the magistrate order was mechanical in nature, Gandhi said the complainant lacked locus standi to file the complaint, as a defamation complaint can only be initiated by the person defamed. He sought stay on proceedings before the magistrate court. The HC adjourned the hearing till November 22.

After HC rap, orders issued to extend aid to widows of three manual scavengers

AFTER A wait of two years, widows of three workers who died while cleaning a septic tank at a Govandi housing society in 2019 are set to get compensation with the state government's social justice department issuing a Government Resolution (GR) in the regard on Tuesday.

A compensation of Rs 10 lakh each was awarded by the High Court to the three women more than two months back, but since the money was not paid, their advocate, Isha Singh, brought the matter to the court's notice earlier this month.

Vimla Govind Chorotiya, Neeta Santoshi Kalshankar, and Bani Vishwaji Dabhadkar had lost their husbands in December 2019. Despite representation made to the Mumbai Suburban Collector in January 2020 for the payment of Rs 10 lakh compensation and rehabilitation in accordance with the Prohibition of Employment of Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation (PMSR) Act, 2013 and the Supreme Court's decision in Safai Karamchari Andolan v/s Union of India case, no compensation was paid to the women for over one-and-a-half year.

The women then approached the Bombay HC through a Writ Petition in June this year, requesting that the state government be directed to pay the compensation and provide rehabilitation. Suburban collector Nidhi Chaudhari did not answer calls.

Singh said, "The GR is a huge win for safai karamcharis because it acknowledges the role of the state when the deaths occur in private societies. As per reviewing the September order, expressed shock and called the case an "eye-opener", Singh added.

"When the State was hesitant to give an undertaking to pay the amount within a week, Katkavalla directed that the undertaking has to be given falling which the court would haul them up for contempt." The court directed that the State report its compliance with the undertaking to the appropriate bench on November 18, 2021 at 5 PM," said Singh.

In its GR, the social justice ministry said that Concrete Builder and Morya SRA CHS had paid Rs 3.75 lakh of which 1.25 lakh was given to each widow. The remaining sum of Rs 26.25 lakh had to be paid to them for which the department has asked the Suburban Collector to recover the money from the society and builder. If the society/builder is not capable enough, then the money should be paid from contingency fund, the GR said.
