Cough syrup abuse: Major supplier linked, goods worth Rs 23 lakh seized

THE ANTI-NARCOTICS Cell of the Mumbai Police busted a major supplier of cocaine phosphate that was used in cough syrups and is abused as a substance in Mumbai and surrounding areas. The menace of abusing cough syrups is especially high in Maharashtra and Gujarat areas.

An officer said that the Ghatkopar unit of the ANC received a tip-off about a consignment of cocaine phosphate being in two godowns on the Ghatkopar-Mankhurd link road.

The team arrested one Mukesh Chaudhari (27), a Virar resident. An officer said that Chaudhari was a major wholesaler of cocaine phosphate and supplied to Mankhurd, Colaba and Jogaeswari among other areas.

On questioning Chaudhari about the source of the bottles, he told the team about a godown in Virar where these syrups were illegally prepared and sent to various parts of the city.

Accordingly, the team raided the factory from where 7,700 illegally procured bottles worth Rs 23 lakh were found and seized.

Inspector T.S. Sutar from the Ghatkopar ANC unit said, "Chaudhari has been arrested in the past as well. Earlier, he worked with another drug peddler but realized he was not making much money. Hence, he started his operation as a supplier of cocaine phosphate."

ADULT FILMS CASE

2 months after arrest, Raj Kundra gets bail

NEARLY TWO months after his arrest by the Mumbai Police crime branch, businessman Raj Kundra was granted bail by a metropolitan magistrate's court in the case pertaining to alleged creation and publishing of pornographic films on mobile applications.

The development came after Kundra filed a fresh bail application last week after a supplementary charge sheet was filed naming him in the case. In his plea filed through lawyer Prashant Patil, Kundra had said that he was being made a scapegoat.

Patil said Kundra is likely to be released on Tuesday after completing bail formalities. He was granted interim protection from arrest, his lawyer said.

The 45-year-old's plea also said that while the police filed a charge sheet against the earlier arrested app developers, there was no evidence or allegation against Kundra. It said that after a "motivated investigation", the supplementary charge sheet was filed against him. He also said that he was "victims" who were earlier being harassed and his plea should be considered on grounds of parity. The bail plea

also said that the police had not been able to show any evidence regarding his connection with mobile apps Hotshots and Bollywood where the said adult films were uploaded. His plea also said that he was not named in the FIR and his name was dragged in the case by the police.

Kundra said that he was associated with Arms Media Prime Limited, the company linked to the content, only between February and December 2019 and that he did not take any active part in contract building or content creation. His plea also said that the Hotshots app had nothing to do with pornography and that the charge sheet also does not state that there were "victims" who were coerced or threatened by Kundra in alleged filming or broadcasting of erotic content.

Kundra's lawyer also argued before the court that the maximum punishment in the offences he is charged with is up to seven years and no purpose will be served in keeping him behind bars. It also said that the Covid-19 pandemic had exposed Kundra to a "potential health hazard".

The Mumbai Police had opposed the plea saying that there could be tampering of evidence and influencing of witnesses.

Meanwhile, the Bombay High Court on Monday continued till October 6 an interim protection from arrest to Kundra and others in a case registered by the Mumbai cyber police in 2020.

The case was based on a complaint alleging that certain online platforms had published obscene videos as part of their "web-series". A single-judge bench of Justice Ajay S Gadlikar was hearing the anticipatory bail plea by Kundra in the 2020 case. On August 18, HC had granted interim protection from arrest till further orders in the 2020 case.

The Court also continued interim protection to co-accused Shrey Chhaya, Poonam Padsey, Litesh Ganpat Kamat and Surojit Chowdhury in the case.

DEFAMATION SUIT

Concerned about media reports on Shilpa Shetty's children, says High Court

THE BOMBAY High Court on Monday said that it was concerned about media reports about actor Shilpa Shetty's minor children following the arrest of her husband Raj Kundra by the Mumbai Police in the adult films case.

A single-judge bench of Justice Gautam S Patel was hearing Shetty's interim application in a defamation suit seeking damages of Rs 25 crore seeking to restrain various media organisations from publishing any "inaccurate, false, malicious and defamatory" content against her on social media and websites in connection with the arrest of Kundra.

On July 30, the bench, while observing that the "right to privacy" required to be balanced with the "freedom of the press", refused to pass any blanket "gag" order granting an interim injunction against the media.

concerned media organisations and private persons running blogs and vlogs. Advocate Abhinav Chandra had representing Shetty on Monday told the court that the plaintiff was in talks with most of the defendant media organisations and most of them have agreed to remove objectionable content.

The bench then asked the plaintiff to divide the defendants into two categories of private persons and traditional media outlets. Justice Patel said that while traditional media will understand 'rational and competent advice', the same cannot be said about private bloggers and vloggers.

Justice Patel added, "I am not concerned about Shilpa Shetty... she will handle herself. I am more concerned about her minor children. Media reports on Shetty's personal life with her children are of concern... in such matter, it is the children, who are in the centre. The court will hear Shetty's plea again on October 1."

Mr. Harish Kumar Garg is the President of The Bombay Presidency Radio Club Limited, and also one of the Founders of Punjab Kesari Charitable Trust. Mr. Garg was solely instrumental for the allotment of 3000 sq. m Plot from CIDCO Ltd. in 1980-1981 for PKC Hospital, Vashi.

Mr. Sanjay Devkinandan Gupta, President, Mr. Ashok S. Nautia, Gen. Secretary and Dr. Sanjay Ramnivas Goel, Chairman of PKC Hospital appointed Dr. (Ex. Col.) Hardeep Singh Bindra (Regn. No. 60529 - Maharashtra Medical Council Mumbai) as the C.E.O. of PKC Hospital in June 2021, by just informing the Managing Committee that Dr. Bindra had taken Pre-Retirement from the defence Hospital at Pune. As a matter of fact Dr. Bindra had been Court Martialled & Convicted under POCSO Act in 2015. Dr. Bindra had been CASHIERED and sentenced to RIGOROUS IMPRISONMENT for 5 years. He was not granted bail but he was later on appealed up to Supreme Court, but failed to get any relief (Petition no. 459 of 2017 in criminal appeal no. 940 of 2016).

Mr. Garg got suspicious, and checked deeply the past history of Dr. Bindra and came to know about the full details of his conviction. Gupta & Goel, for the reasons best known to them, did dilly-dallying and no action was initiated by them. Mr. Garg contacted the HRA of PKC Hospital and informed her all the details of the past history of Dr. Bindra to her. Thereafter only, Dr. Bindra was asked to resign & go.

Before joining PKC Hospital, Dr. Bindra had worked as Consultant Cardiac Surgery with Seven Hills Hospital, Marol, Andheri for some period, obviously without disclosing to them about his having been convicted under POCSO Act.
