Trying to stop man who snatched her phone, woman falls off local train

Accused nabbed by commuters; woman fights for her life

A 49-YEAR-OLD woman is fighting for her life in the ICU unit of a government hospital after she fell off a running local train while trying to stop a robber who stole her mobile phone.

The incident took place on Monday. The accused, who has a prior criminal record, was nabbed by commuters who were alerted by the screams and commotion.

The incident took place at 6.38 pm on platform no. 2 of Mahim railway station while the victim, Priyanka Khodke, was traveling to Dadar station.

Khodke, a resident of Badlapur, works as a clerk at a ration office in Santacruz. She took the train from Santacruz station on the Western Railway line and was heading to Dadar station on Central Railway line to take a train to Badlapur.

As the train started to depart, the man got into the compartment, snatched Khodke's phone and jumped off the running train. She tried to catch him

The accused, Ramzan alias Yasinuddin Khan, 28, was standing on the platform outside the women's general compartment.

As the train started to depart, he got into the compartment, snatched Khodke's phone and jumped off the running train.

Khodke tried to catch him and in the process, fell off the running train. She sustained serious injuries to her head. Other commuters, alerted by her screams and the commotion, nabbed Khan. He was handed over to the patrolling police at

the spot. In the meantime, Khodke, who fell on the platform, was rushed to Sion government hospital. She is in an unconscious condition and being treated for head injuries. Her damaged phone, worth Rs 15,000, has been recovered by police from the spot.

Khan, a resident of Matunga labour camp, has three to four cases of robbery and theft registered against him.

Based on a police officer's complaint, an FIR has been registered against Khan under sections 394 (causing hurt while committing robbery) and 338 (causing grievous hurt by act endangering life or personal safety of others) of the Indian Penal Code at Mumbai Central Government Railway Police (GRP) station.

After his police custody ended, Khan was sent to judicial custody and lodged in a jail where he will remain till court grants him bail.

Deadline for Ambedkar memorial extended to March 2024

Mumbai: The memorial of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar, being built by the Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA), will now be ready by March 2024, the authority said on Wednesday.

While work on the project was started in 2018, it was expected to be completed by February 21, this year. However, changes made in the structure and design of the memorial pushed the deadline to March 2024, said officials.

So far, 49 per cent of the overall work and 6 per cent work on the memorial building have been completed. The memorial is being built at Indu Mill in Dadar over an area of 4.84 hectare. —VALLABH OZARKAR

'Smriti Sthal impacting organisational activities', RSS asks BMC for alternate plot

CITING HINDRANCE in conducting its organisational activities due to Shiv Sena founder Bala Thackeray's Smriti Sthal at Shivaji Park in Dadar, the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) has written to the BMC seeking an alternate plot for itself. While the letter from the Dadar unit of RSS is dated October 2021, the matter came to light on Wednesday.

The letter written on RSS letterhead by a person named

Nitin Narayan Mhatre said that the BMC had handed over a 1,755 sq m plot in Shivaji Park to RSS in 1967 on lease under the Vacant Land Tenancy (VLT) scheme. The plot was used for daily Shakha activities like exercise.

"However, now the Sangh's organisational activities are impacted due to Thackeray's Smriti Sthal. Considering this, the BMC should in exchange provide another land near Nana Nani Park in Shivaji Park. Also, we are ready to pay the dues of property tax. We have been paying property tax and rent to

BMC till 2011-12 and submitted all the documents to BMC's G North ward," the letter stated. After Bal Thackeray passed away in 2012, a memorial was built at Shivaji Park in 2013.

Officials from the BMC said that a proposal is under consideration of the estate department. "We are checking all our records related to Shivaji Park. Although there is no policy on exchange of such plots since the BMC has stopped giving land on lease under VLT scheme, an appropriate decision will be taken," said an official.

Covid and the Fourth wave - "Corona far from over"

"Corona is here to stay" will keep having New Waves

Globally confirmed cases of Covid-19 are about 464M, with deaths being about 6M as per WHO. In India, there have been about 43M confirmed cases with about 0.5M deaths, from 3rd January 2020 till 18th March 2022, with about 1 billion eight hundred five million vaccine doses administered. A team of researchers has predicted that a fourth wave might soon hit India in June 2022 and will last for four months. Countries like Germany, the US, India have seen the third wave, and countries like South Africa, and Zimbabwe have started to face the fourth and higher waves of covid-19. Managing through all the waves healthily is the need of time. As per the studies, building up immunity is the key to surviving through the covid-19. Dietary supplements play a crucial role in preventing SARS-CoV-2 infection and in those who are infected will reduce the severity in them.

Micronutrients have an important role in the immune system and could result in beneficial effects in COVID-19 outcomes. Minerals such as selenium which is an anti-oxidant help to improve renal complications that are associated with inflammation, oxidative stress. Selenium has been recommended as an adjuvant in Covid-19 infections because of its beneficial effects on cellular immunity that provides the defense with the release of cytokines and chemokines in response to an antigen.

Vitamin D may play a role as an immunosuppressant by inhibiting cytokine release syndrome, therefore Vitamin D deficiency makes the body prone to infections. Zinc

deficiency affects the immune system and zinc deficiency is also associated with respiratory diseases. Zinc has antiviral and anti-inflammatory responses. Niacinamide enhances the therapeutic efficacy of antiviral agents and improves creatinine trajectory among patients with severe COVID-19 related acute kidney injury. Vitamin C has a protective effect on the lungs against viral infections. Aspirin possesses anti-thrombotic, anti-inflammatory, and antiviral activity. Studies have suggested that promethazine block SARS-CoV-2 endocytosis in the respiratory epithelium. Iodine also possesses antiviral activity.

Along with nutrition, it is still very important to take all the precautions. All the precautionary fac-

tors together will help to manage the spread of the most dreaded disease, India was the country to record very low numbers of covid-19 positive cases of people in comparison to the second wave. The second wave observed more cases most likely due to the new variants found (B.1.617.1 and B.1.617.2). By December 2021, India had the third wave with Omicron variant, with the omicron wave still there, researchers have predicted the fourth wave of Covid-19 pandemic in India may start around June 22nd and peak to late August. Viruses will continue to mutate and hence we need to learn to live with them. As of December 2021 studies have found five variants of SARS-CoV-2 among global populations which are the Alpha-Variant (formerly called the UK Variant and referred to as B.1.1.7), the Beta-Variant (formerly called the South Africa Variant and referred to as B.1.351), the Gamma-Variant (formerly called the Brazil Variant and referred to as P.1), the Delta-Variant (formerly called the India Variant and referred to as B.1.617.2) and the Omicron-Variant (formerly called the South Africa Variant and referred to as B.1.1.529). The variants are more infectious and cause more severe symptoms, consult the doctor immediately if you have a fever, wear a mask, maintain physical distance, have a healthy diet and nutrition, and get vaccinated and follow all the government-imposed rules for isolation to sail through all the waves of COVID.
