# HC grants protection from arrest to Rasmji Shukla till April 1

MUMBAI, MARCH 11

THE BOMBAY High Court on Friday granted interim protection from arrest till April 1 to former IPS officer Rasmji Shukla in connection to her plea against a phone tapping FIR lodged by the Colaba police in Mumbai.

Shukla promised to cooperate with the probe and to appear before investigating officer, Inspector S Mohite, on March 16 and 23 from 11 am to 1 pm. A division bench of Justice Prasanna B Varde and Justice Shiram M Modak was hearing Shukla's plea against the FIR, registered on March 2, for alleged tapping of phone calls of Shiv Sena's Sanjay Raut and NCP's Eknath Khadse. Shukla's plea, filed through advocate Sameer Nangre, claimed that the FIR was lodged with political motive and she

was being falsely implicated in the matter. Additional Commissioner of Police (Special Branch) Rajiv Jain is the complainant in the case. Shukla said that she apprehended that despite the offence levelled against her being bailable, in the guise of seeking release from the petitioner, the authority may detain her. Senior advocate Mahesh Jethmalani, representing Shukla, said that if the petitioner is un-

able to respond or call the investigating authority, her failure to appear before the authority would be adversely considered against her and therefore she should be granted interim relief till next hearing. Chief Public Prosecutor Aruna Pai, appearing for the state, said that the probe is at an early stage. Pai opposed the prayer for interim relief stating that the offences are bailable and there was no question of making arrest at present. The HC accepted Shukla's undertaking and Jethmalani said she is ready to cooperate with the probe if certain dates are stipulated for her to appear before the authority. On March 4, the HC had granted Shukla protection from arrest till following March 10, while she seeks a quashing of an FIR lodged against her in Pune in connection with the alleged illegal phone tapping of state

Congress president Nana Patole during the tenure of the previous BJP-led government in Maharashtra. The HC had "prima facie" observed delay in registering FIR and noted that Shukla, being a high-ranking officer, required to be given interim protection. On Friday, the bench said: "We are of the opinion that petitioner (Shukla) made out a case for interim relief. State not to take coercive steps against her till the next date of hearing." After the state lawyer sought that Shukla's plea against Colaba and Pune FIRs be heard together, the bench accepted the same and posted next hearing for April 1. Meanwhile, the Colaba police has summoned Rasmji Shukla for a hearing on March 10. We sent her summons to her official email account. We have also personally informed her regarding the summons," said an officer.

# MSRTC STRIKE HC seeks govt stand on panel report by March 22

THE BOMBAY High Court on Friday directed the Maharashtra government to file a reply by March 22, giving its stand on the report submitted by a court-appointed three-member committee, constituted to look into the demand of Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) workers to be treated as government employees. Nearly 90,000 MSRTC staffers have been on strike since last year. The government has assured that it will not take any disciplinary action against the employees from Friday till the next date of hearing on March 22. A division bench of Chief Justice Dipankar Datta and Justice Makrand S Karnik was hearing contempt plea in a writ petition filed by the MSRTC against employees' trade union and others, seeking the court to direct all staffers to refrain from participating in strikes or stopping work. Advocate SC Naidu, appearing for the state, told HC that copies of report, which was tabled in state Assembly on March 4, has been circulated to the parties to the case. Naidu added that because of the ongoing Budget Session of the state legislature, a decision could not be taken on the report and the same is likely to be taken in short time. The HC was also informed that the report of the Committee had come up before the state Cabinet. The court then asked the state to inform whether it was willing to accept the report before the next hearing on March 22. In the report, the panel has said that the merger of MSRTC with the state-owned and treating its employees as government employees is not possible due to "administrative and practical issues".

# Court rejects Rana Kapoor plea over bank's sanction to prosecute him

A SPECIAL court on Thursday rejected a Rana Kapoor claim that the sanction to prosecute him issued by the Board of Directors of the bank was invalid. The court agreed with the CBI's contention that as per the rules, a sanction to prosecute him under the Prevention of Corruption Act could only be issued by the Reserve Bank of India. Since it was done by the Board of Directors, the sanction was invalid, he had submitted.

The plea was in connection with the Avantha Realty case where it is alleged that Kapoor had abused his official position as an MD and CEO of Yes Bank to acquire a property registered to the bank against a loan taken by the realty company. The CBI opposed Kapoor's plea had submitted that the Board of Directors had gone through the evidence placed before them and applied their minds as the sanctioning authority in issuing the sanction to prosecute him. Kapoor had also raised the issue that since the sanction was issued mechanically without application of mind, "...the grounds as raised by the applicant/accused that the sanction was not accorded by the competent authority and, was issued mechanically like the ground of invalidity of sanction on account of non-application of mind. As such, it has to be raised in the course of the trial," special judge MR Purwar said in his order, referring to previous orders by the Supreme Court.

Kapoor has been behind bars since 2020 for multiple cases filed against him alleging corruption and money-laundering.

# Businessman held for selling low quality salt as Tata Salt

Mumbai: The Economic Offence Wing (EOW) of the Mumbai Police Crime Branch on Thursday arrested a 49-year-old businessman from Versova for allegedly selling low quality salt as Tata Salt. The police said Prakash Durgaprasad Madiga has been booked under Copyright and Trademark Act, 1957, as he would wrap the low quality salt in packets of Tata Salt to dupe consumers. A raid was conducted at Madiga's godown in Versova and 87 sacks of salt - weighing 4,245 kg - were seized. An officer said, "The would charge Rs 2 less when compared to the original suppliers of Tata Salt." ENS

# HC pulls up two contractors for delay in installation of CCTVs at police stations

PULLING UP the two contractors who installed CCTV cameras in police stations across Maharashtra, the Bombay High Court on Friday asked them to give an undertaking and inform the court by March 15 how and when the installation work and rectification of glitches in non-functional systems will be completed.

The court also questioned the state why only two contractors were shortlisted for complying with State Court directions and hoped that over Rs 60 crore sanctioned for the project was utilised properly as it is "public money". A division bench of Justice J Kathawalla and Justice Milind N Jadhav had on Monday directed the two contractors to remain present in court on Friday after it was informed that 711 of the over 5,000 CCTV cameras installed are non-functional. The HC was also informed that the contractors have already

been paid. The state had told HC that Rs 62.3 crore was commissioned for installing CCTV cameras at police stations. While a work order was issued in November 2020, the work was not completed by April, this year. Two contractors - Sujata Computers Private Limited from Pune and Javni Systems India Private Limited from Bengaluru - were selected to execute the project, which included maintenance of the CCTVs and instruments for five years from August 6, 2021. The government had told the court that there are 1,089 police stations in the state and so far, 6,092 cameras had been installed in 547 of them. The representatives of the contractors were present in the court on Friday.

Advocate General Ashutosh Kumbhakar, representing the state, said the two contractors had expressed regret for delay and were willing to give an undertaking explaining the same and when the work will be completed. He added that the

contractors were selected based on their past work. The contractors said that they had completed nearly 65 per cent of the work and the rest will be completed within 8-10 days. After the bench sought to know why the government did not choose the services of reputed and big firms like L&T that had installed CCTV cameras across traffic signals in Mumbai, Kumbhakar said the company did not engage in the work as the contract amount was too less for it.

The HC said that it did not care even if the budget was Rs 650 crore, as long as the installation was completed and "SC order must be complied with fully" and "the end result" be achieved. The bench said, "We are not at all satisfied with the way these contracts were given... There were 13 more bidders and the only thing is that bids by these two were considerably low, and very similar to each other. The HC posted next hearing to March 15.
