### Education dept readies bridge courses to fill learning loss during Covid

REALISING THE unusual learning loss that the students have suffered due to Covid-19 pandemic, the school education department of Maharashtra has prepared a module of remedial teaching to be implemented as schools restart in June after the summer break.

The module consists of assessment of students to identify learning loss, grade-wise bridge courses and training for teachers for effective implementation.

With the new academic year, while all students will be expected to study new syllabus in higher grades, they will have to wait till they complete the bridge courses. According to the department, it is important to gauge how much have they understood from the earlier classes. Before the bridge courses are introduced, students will be assessed, and teachers will be trained to provide required remedial teaching.

"It is a very unusual condition and there cannot be a one size fits all corrective measure. Though an assessment module will be prepared to identify the learning loss, it is going to be different for all and so the remedial teaching will have to be individual student oriented. Considering this, focus will be to train teachers. An online training module will be provided for teachers," said Suraj Mandhare, Commissioner of Education, adding that the department also plans to start a help-line service for teachers.

The coping module has been prepared by the State Council for Educational Research and Training. The bridge courses will be as per the required learning outcomes of different grades. As schools restart in June, assessments will be held to first understand the learning loss before these bridge courses are introduced. New curriculum of higher classes will begin only after the bridge course.

# HC refuses anticipatory bail to school chairman booked for student's suicide

## Accused had scolded the 16-year-old boy in an 'unruly manner', observed court

THE BOMBAY High Court recently refused protection from arrest to the chairman of a Kolhapur-based school, booked for allegedly abetting the suicide of a 16-year-old student.

The court observed that the accused had scolded the boy in an "unruly manner" and prima facie "created an impression in (the) student's mind to put him in deep frustration".

Justice Vinay G Joshi was hearing an anticipatory bail plea filed by Ganpatrao Janardhan Patil, booked by the Shirol

MIDC police for offences punishable under Indian Penal Code (IPC) and provisions of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

The FIR, lodged on April 2 based on a police complaint filed by the grandfather, stated that the boy was a student of Class X at Symbolic International School, of which Patil was the chairman and his wife the principal. On April 1, the man received a message asking him to come to the school.

In the school, as per the complaint, he was asked to take his grandson home. The boy told him that while he was playing

football, a goal post guard inadvertently hit a girl, injuring her. Following this, Patil allegedly scolded and abused the boy in filthy language.

The grandfather told the police that when he met Patil, the accused told him that his grandson had injured the girl and is "ill-cultured and there are no chances of reformation and he is a slum boy".

As per the complaint, Patil also claimed that the school principal had informed him that in the past, the boy had behaved in an unruly manner and should be rusticated. The FIR stated that Patil abused the boy in the presence of a school teacher.

As the grandfather took the boy home, he died allegedly by suicide a few hours later.

Advocates Hrishikesh Mundargi and Pravada Raut, appearing for Patil, argued that the allegations, at their face value, nowhere disclose adequate mens rea (criminal intention) and him being the school chairman and a part of the disciplinary authority, his act of reprimanding a student cannot be construed as sufficient instigation for the alleged suicide.

Advocate MR Tidke, appearing for the police, stated that Patil's act amounts to sufficient instigation and as the probe was in progress, his custodial inter-

rogation was required.

Justice Joshi observed: "The utterances of the applicant are objectionable. No doubt, he can reprimand students, but not in such a language, which would shatter the tender mind. As per the statements of witnesses, the applicant has scolded the deceased minor boy in an unruly manner... Prima facie it suggests that the applicant has created an impression in the mind of the student to put him in deep frustration."

He added that "there is a direct link between the death and Patil's act since within a few hours of the episode, the child ended his life."

# After 11 years, court frames charges against Pune stud farm owner Hasan Ali Khan

OVER A decade after a case was filed against Pune stud farm owner Hasan Ali Khan on charges of money-laundering, a special court on Tuesday framed charges against him. Khan was arrested by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in 2011 and remained behind bars for over four years till he got bail in 2015.

On Tuesday, the court framed charges against Khan over a video conference, which he attended from Pune. The court considered Khan's age, health and long pendency of the case, to allow the charges to be framed through video conference. The charges, including sections of money laundering under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), were read out to him.

Khan pleaded not guilty to the charges. The court also allowed his lawyer, Prashant Patil, to sign the statement as Khan is bedridden and hospitalised. Patil also requested the court to expedite the trial stating that the case has been pending for a long time, causing hardship to his client.

Special Judge MG Deshpande directed the lawyer to go through the documents to expedite the trial. The court also directed the special public prosecutor Sanjana Sharma to provide copies to the accused. "ED shall note that long dates will not be kept in the matter, and they should bring their first witness as early as possible," the court said.

Khan's co-accused in the case, Kashinath Tapuria, had passed away pending trial. Khan had approached the court seeking to expedite the trial. A petition was also filed by him before the Bombay

High Court stating his medical condition and that may die without a fair trial.

A case was filed against Khan in 2007 and the chargesheet was filed in 2011. The draft charges in the case were submitted in 2018. Last month, the court issued a non-bailable warrant against Khan after he failed to remain present for multiple hearings.

A case was filed against Khan by the ED based on an investigation by the Income Tax department, which claimed that his income was Rs 1.1 lakh crore, and it was alleged that he had \$8 billion in 2007 in the United Bank of Switzerland. It was subsequently claimed that the charge was made based on a letter written by the bank to Khan, which was later alleged to be forged. In his petition in the High Court, Khan had claimed that there was no evidence against him to frame charges.

# TENDER FOR 1,400 ELECTRIC BUSES HC seeks BEST's reply to Tata Motor's plea against disqualification

THE BOMBAY High Court on Monday directed the Brijnagar Electric Supply and Transport (BEST) to reply to a writ petition filed by Tata Motors Limited, challenging BEST's May 6 decision to disqualify the company from taking part in the tender process for 1,400 electric buses for allegedly deviating from tender specifications.

On February 26, the BEST had published a tender notice for the operation of stage carriage services of 1,400 single decker AC electric buses (with driver) for Mumbai and its suburbs on gross cost contract (GCC) model for 12 years.

As per BEST's plea, Tata Motors made its pre-bid submissions on March 11, requesting for certain technical modifications and submitted its financial and technical bid for tender on April 25. On May 6, BEST published a technical suitability evaluation of the tender and disqualified Tata Motors, prompting it to approach HC.

The tender was won by Evey Trans Private Limited, with the order being valued at nearly Rs 2,450 crore.

Justice Nitin Sambre and Justice Anil Pansare was on Monday hearing a plea by Tata Motors, urging HC to review BEST's decision.

Tata Motors, through senior advocate Mustafa Doctor and briefed by team of Karanjawala & Company, argued that the company's technical bid was arbitrarily rejected to give unfair favour to Evey Trans.

The company said that BEST selectively relaxed norms - like permitting a bus to be charged every one hour - to allow other bidders and this benefited Evey Trans. It further said that BEST waived requirements like the need to match rates while evaluating bids.

Further, Tata Motors said that its bid, in conformity with tender conditions, had provided a guarantee that its buses can ply 200 km with a charge of 80 per cent without any interruption.

The plea said the BEST had erroneously declared the bid submitted by Tata Motors as "technically non-responsive" and sought it to be reviewed.

However, senior advocate Sharan Jagtiani, appearing for BEST, denied the claims. The HC asked BEST to file a reply to the plea and posted next hearing to May 23.

# First Olive Ridley turtle satellite-tagged on state coast returns near nesting beach

FOUR MONTHS after it became the first Olive Ridley sea turtle to be satellite-tagged on the coast of Maharashtra, Prathama has returned to near its nesting beach - Velas in the Ratnagiri district - to the surprise of researchers. Prathama, which had left state waters sometime in late March, was spotted 80 km offshore near Velas beach.

Five Turtles - Prathama, Savani (on January 25), Vanashree, Rewa and Laxmi (on February 13 and 16) - were tagged with platform transmitter terminals (PTTs), which were fitted with epoxy resin on the carapace (hard shell) of the turtle in Ratnagiri district. Each transmitter weighs less than three per cent of the adult turtle's body weight, which ranges between 40 and 45 kg. But on March 2, the researchers had lost contact with one of the turtles christened Laxmi.

Dr R Suresh Kumar, senior

scientist from the Department of Endangered Species Management, WII, Dehradun, said had not anticipated the trajectory taken by Prathama. "My initial hypothesis was that these solitary nesting turtles will move into the deep sea to return now and then. However, all the tagged turtles have remained within the continental shelf."

The continental shelf has relatively shallow water, which then gives way to the slope and then the deep sea ocean.

The initial hypothesis by the researchers monitoring the tur-

tlés was that the turtles were likely to remain in the nearshore or shallow water, waiting for the ocean currents to begin their journeys into the deep sea further down to Lakshadweep or drift towards Oman or Somali coastline and return later this year in October-November to nearshore waters.

It was suspected that once the currents start to set in near the shore in March, the turtles will move into the deep sea. However, except Rewa, which is on the edge of the continental shelf, all are within the continental shelf. Kumar said he believes that Rewa is currently foraging. "I am assuming that the nutrient-rich food is brought up along the slope (continental shelf). I suspect that all these turtles will move to the place where Rewa is, where the food is available in good amount. Turtles are somewhat able to predict ocean water circulation and they time themselves to be there where the food is going to come up."

Kumar added, "The satellite tagging is helping us further un-

derstand their behaviour."

Researchers from the Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Dehradun, and the Mangrove Foundation, an autonomous body under the Maharashtra government, are monitoring the turtles' movement to understand the migratory pattern of the solitary nesting turtles.

Olive Ridley turtles are considered the most abundant sea turtles in the world with sporadic nesting in Maharashtra, Goa and the offshore Andaman Islands.

In Maharashtra, sporadic nesting is recorded across three districts in the southernmost region of the state - Raigad, Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg. In these three, the highest number of nests and hatchlings is recorded on the three beaches of Guhagar, Velas and Anjarle in the Ratnagiri district.

# State government releases pending funds to MRVC for completion of rail projects

AFTER A delay of over two years later, the state government has started releasing its share of pending funds to the Mumbai Rail Vikas Corporation (MRVC) for completing the ongoing railway infrastructure-related projects in Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR).

Earlier this month, the MMRDA had released Rs 150 crore and another instalment of Rs 150 crore was released this week for Mumbai Urban Transport Projects (MUTP) 2 and 3 projects. An official said even though they have received Rs 300 crore so far for the MUTP 2 and 3 projects, Rs 700 crore is still due for the other projects.

MRVC CPRO Sunil Udasi confirmed that they have received Rs 300 crore from the state government through MMRDA.

Recently, the MMRDA had written to the Urban Development Ministry of the state government conveying that due to the ongoing big-ticket infrastructure project for which it has taken loans, it is unable to pay its share for the MUTP 3A projects of MRVC.

The MRVC is a joint Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) of the Ministry of Railways and the Government of Maharashtra that undertakes major railway-related infrastructure projects under the Mumbai Urban Transport Projects (MUTP).

MRVC plans to spend Rs 1,200-Rs 1,500 crore for the MUTP railway project this financial year. The cost of the project are shared by the state government and the Indian railways at a ratio of 49:51.

However, the state government had not paid its share for the past three years which accumulated to over Rs 1,000 crore.

# State election panel likely to finalise poll dates by July-end

THE STATE Election Commission (SEC) on Monday said that it is likely to finalise the dates for elections to 14 municipal corporations, including Mumbai, Pune and Pimpri-Chinchwad civic bodies, as well as many other local bodies by the end of July.

The SEC said that the Supreme Court (SC) on Tuesday allowed it to take a call depending on the upcoming monsoon situation in different parts of the state.

"The Supreme Court has allowed us to take a call regarding holding municipal corporation, zilla parishad, panchayat samiti and gram panchayat elections depending on the rain situation by the end of July," SEC Secretary Kiran Kurundkar told *The Indian Express*.

Kurundkar added, "In today's hearing before the SC, we put on record details regarding the elections. We told the SC that the pre-election process has been restarted and we will need till July-end to complete it. We also told the court that we needed time to update voters' list and declare quota for SC and ST seats."

"Though we have completed the process of finalising boundaries of wards of municipal corporations, we need to complete the process for other local self-government bodies."

Kurundkar said during the last hearing, the SC had directed the SEC to announce elections in two weeks. "However, at today's hearing, the SC agreed with our

submissions and allowed us till July to decide about holding the election depending on the monsoon situation," he added.

Officials at SEC said they will decide the course of action once they receive the copy of the SC order.

Shiv Sena Minister Anil Parab said that the poll dates will be decided by the poll panel. "We are ready to face elections any time," he added.

The state has to hold elections to several local bodies, including 14 municipal corporations, 25 zilla parishads, 284 panchayat samitis, 2,000 gram panchayats as well as 220 nagar panchayats and nagar parishads.

Municipal corporation elections in the state were supposed to be held in February but that didn't happen over the OBC quota issue. The SC had rejected the 27 per cent OBC reservation in civic bodies.

Last year, the SC stayed had OBC quota until the state set up a dedicated commission, which had provided the court empirical data on the political backwardness of OBCs in local bodies. The SC found the data inadequate and rejected the same. It had then asked the state to hold the polls without the OBC quota.

# IndusInd Bank invokes 14.6m pledged shares of Birla Tyres

 IndusInd Bank has invoked around 14.6 million pledged shares of BK Birla group company Birla Tyres, amounting to 10.21% of the total equity share capital of the insolvent tyre maker.

Notably, earlier this month, the Kolkata bench of the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) ordered initiation of the insolvency proceedings against Birla Tyres, admitting an insolvency petition of SRF Limited, an operational creditor of the tyre maker, for default of making the payment of over ₹1.5 crore.

The application filed by SRF, under Section 9 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC), for initiating the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (CIRP) against Birla Tyres, the corporate debtor, was admitted, said the NCLT Kolkata bench in its order dated May 5.  
 In a stock exchange filing

on Tuesday, Birla Tyres said IndusInd Bank invoked around 14.6 million pledged shares of the company on May 10. And, the reason for encumbrance was collateral for term loans of ₹71.11 crore availed of by Cygnit Industries, a wholly-owned subsidiary of BK Birla flagship Kesoram Industries.  
 Promoters held 50.91% stake in Birla Tyres at the end of the third quarter last fiscal. For the last fiscal, the company's total income stood at ₹22.44 crore, while net loss was at ₹655.67 crore.  
 Significantly, Deloitte Haskins & Sells, statutory auditors of the company, tendered resignation on May 11, 2022.

 Sa-Dhan is an RBI-recognised self-regulatory organisation for microfinance institutions. In the last quarter of FY22, the industry's total loan portfolio registered a growth of 1.3%.

 A positive growth is expected in the first quarter of the current fiscal and the trend is likely to continue throughout the fiscal, Satish added.  
 Despite around 5% Y-o-Y growth in MFIs' total portfolio, the portfolio of banks decreased by 7% to ₹1,02,527 crore as of March 31, 2022. The loan portfolio of NBFC-MFIs grew 19% to ₹94,096 crore as of end-March. Total disbursement declined 6.84% to ₹85,667 crore in Q4 FY22.  
 The report said that while funds flow to the sector has improved, small MFIs are struggling in accessing funds from banks.
