LIKE THE Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC), the Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation (PCMC) too has made it mandatory for citizens to apply for licence from it for keeping cats as pets. Significantly, PCMC has decided to impose a fine of Rs 500 if owners refuse to clean the poop of their pet cats.

The decision has been taken following numerous complaints from citizens, especially from housing societies over sanitation problems resulting from pets like cats.

"PCMC standing committee last week approved a proposal making licence compulsory for domesticating cats. Accordingly, we are preparing the software for the purpose. In a month's time, citizens who have pets like cats will have to apply for licence from PCMC. Already, citizens are seeking licence from us for dogs," PCMC veterinary officer Dr Arun Dagade told this newspaper on Tuesday.

Last week, PMC made it mandatory for citizens to seek licence from it if they are domesticating cats.

Officials said citizens seeking

licence for keeping cats will have to register with the veterinary department and provide relevant documents like copy of Aadhaar card and picture of the cat they wish to keep as pet. The annual licence fee for pet cats will be Rs 75, which will have to be renewed every year.

But why has PCMC suddenly taken the decision to make licence mandatory for cats? Dr Dagade said there have been regular complaints from citizens about unhygienic conditions resulting from pet cats. "We get regular complaints about littering and unhygienic conditions due to cats. Complaints come from those who do not keep pets at home. Many of them say cats

create nuisance in societies and owners do not clear the poop," said Dr Dagade.

In case of pet cats, owners will have to ensure they scoop the poop and throw it at a proper place. "If we get complaints regarding unhygienic conditions created by cats in a residential society, our inspectors will visit the place and carry out an inspection. An on-the-spot Rs 500 fine will be imposed on the owner if it is found that poop or littering by cats has not been cleared," Dr Dagade said.

He, however, said PCMC can't do much about stray cats. "Who will we fine if the cats are not domesticated? At best, we will catch the stray cats and sterilise them so as to reduce their population," Dr Dagade said.

Animals lovers and citizens have their own take on PCMC's move. "It is a good move. This will ensure that people who domesticate cats don't let them loose. It is often observed that citizens who have pet cats don't care about them. These pets often dirty their neighbours' place. They are also found roaming freely in society premises," said Aryan Palaskar, a resident of Indrayninagar.

Riddhi Shanbag, an animal lover who lives in Vastu Udyog

area of Pimpri-Chinchwad, said, "It is good that PCMC is according legality to domesticated cats. It is also a good step as owners will now take more care and be vigilant about them."

The Shanbag family takes care of stray cats by regularly feeding them. "However, we are facing obstacles as some people are objecting to it. In such cases, I think PCMC will be helpful in ensuring that strays are taken care of at a proper shelter home. PCMC can ensure food for stray cats at their facilities," said Riddhi.

Rishikesh Marale, a resident of Kasarwadi, said, "It's good that PCMC has asked cat owners to have licence but along with this it should also provide proper facilities for them. Currently, if a cat requires a major surgery, we have to go to Aundh hospital, which is outside PCMC limits. Such facilities are not available in PCMC's pet hospital despite it being a big municipal corporation."

Deepti Patil, a resident of Rahatni, said, "I don't think this is a wise decision taken by PCMC as a cat as a pet doesn't stay in a single house. It keeps moving around." She said licence can be applied for imported cats. "I feel this decision was taken by PCMC with an eye on revenue," she said.

Second PetGala, mega adoption drive in city

Over 1L residential units unsold till Sept

PUNE HAS reported 1.02 lakh unsold residential units by the end of September 2022. This accounts for 16 per cent of the total available stock across the top seven cities in the country, shows analysis of data by real estate consultancy firm Anarock.

As per the report released Tuesday, this inventory comes despite healthy sales reported by the sector in the city. Anarock research estimates that it would take 23 months for the city to absorb this unsold stock. "Inventory measured in months indicates the number of months it will take for the current unsold housing stock on the market to sell at the current absorption rate. An inventory overhang of 18-24 months is considered relatively healthy," said Prashant Thakur, senior director and head, research, Anarock group.

As per the report, the unsold inventory is mostly because of new supply added in January-September period this year and also the entire 2021. "Research indicates that as many as 45,800 units have been added in the city in 2022 till September. It is largely due to this robust addition of the new stock that the inventory stock has increased. The sales momentum continues to be strong in the city," he said.

"Majority of housing units in the city's inventory are concentrated in the mid segment, contributing 45 per cent... affordable housing segment saw the second highest stock, with 26 per cent units. Pune has an inventory overhang of 23 months by the end of the third quarter... a three-month decrease from the previous quarter," the report read.

NGO flags action over excessive water use as no meters at PMC officers' residences

THE PUNE Municipal Corporation (PMC) has drawn flak for issuing notices of legal action to consumers using more than 150 litres of water per person per day ever since an NGO's independent enquiry revealed that meters haven't been installed at the residences of the municipal commissioner and other officers of the civic body.

Following the PMC notices to consumers with meters over their excessive water consumption, NGO Sajag Nagrik Manch (SNM) sought information from the civic administration on the

water consumed in the official residences of the municipal commissioner, the additional municipal commissioner, the Mayor, and other such properties, only to be informed that the water meters were not installed on said properties. "Officers from the civic water department admitted they were yet to install water meters on properties occupied by the municipal commissioner, the additional municipal commissioner and the Mayor's bungalow," said SNM representative Vivek Velankar.

"The PMC should have set an example by installing water meters in the civic properties occupied by civic officers before reaching out to the public for the same,"

Velankar said, adding that the PMC is harassing the public.

This embarrassment for the PMC comes close on the heels of coming under the Centre's scanner for failing to complete the 24*7 water supply project of metering consumers in the city. The PMC has been directed to complete by March 2023 the project which includes metering all consumers. Despite starting it five years ago, the PMC has failed to complete even 25 per cent of the project.

PMC water supply department head Annurudha Pawaskar said the civic body has put up hoardings around prominent locations to encourage citizens to install water meters on their properties.

State disburses another Rs 8 cr for phase 1 of Wildlife Transit Treatment Centre in Pune

THE MAHARASHTRA government has disbursed another installment of funds -- Rs 8.48 crore -- towards the first phase of the Wildlife Transit Treatment Centre (TTC), which is under construction in Bavdhan in Pune. The treatment centre is an unique multispeciality hospital for injured and disabled wild animals.

In November 2018, the government had approved establishing a treatment centre on a 22-acre plot in Bavdhan. The estimated cost of the project is Rs 87 crore. It includes setting up of speciality treatment centres and

post-treatment recovery centres for deer, antelope, and mammals in phase one. The total cost of this phase is Rs 23 crore.

Work for phase one of the project also includes road construction, fire safety, a veterinary hospital building, electric and other civil works. The government has disbursed a total of Rs 14 crore in 2020 and 2021 for it.

Presently, 100 per cent work has been completed for the treatment and recovery centre for mammals, 93 per cent of work on the veterinary hospital has been completed, 79 per cent of road work has been completed, 79 per cent of work has been completed for the antelope treatment centre, and 45 per cent on the deer treatment centre,

The Forest department's Pune unit also made a presentation about the centre before the Maharashtra government earlier this month.

Approval for phase 2 of the project, which is estimated to cost Rs 47 crore, is awaited. The next phase includes treatment centres for felines, canines, primates, birds, and reptiles. The centre is likely to include a crematorium and a post-mortem room as well.

A senior forest official from Pune, who is in-charge of the project, said, "For government approval for phase 2 of the project, which has eight separate and extensive components, we made a presentation to the Forest department on November 1."

Muktidham crematorium to switch to CNG fuel: Cantonment Board CEO

THE PUNE Cantonment Board (PCB) Tuesday said the Muktidham crematorium near Dhobighat will soon switch to environment-friendly CNG. PCB CEO Subrat Pal informed media persons that the now non-functional crematorium is expected to be relaunched by mid-January. "This is a unique public-private sector initiative," Pal said, adding that the Lions Club of Bibwewadi has volunteered to raise funds to the tune of Rs 1 crore for the project and undertake the construction work.

At a press conference in Pune, members of the Lions Club of Bibwewadi, including secretary Govind Chauhan and spokesperson Mahendra Oswal, said residents in neighbouring areas like Salisbury Park, Gultekdi and Market Yard, among others, were facing difficulties owing to the closure of the crematorium. The electric crematorium has not been functioning for the last 10 months due to technical glitches, PCB officials said.

"We have to perform the last rites at other crematoriums or wait for hours to use the wooden pyre," Lions Club members said. The electric crematorium was

set up in 2003 and by 2016 was in need of repairs. Pal told media persons. However, the board was unable to take up major repairs owing to financial constraints in 2017.

It is an electric furnace and needs continuous supply of fuel. The furnace has deteriorated and heat is leaking from inside. The 30-ft chimney has also rusted and deteriorated at the base. In April this year, the chimney collapsed due to heavy winds.

"Changes are also required as per norms of the pollution control board. There is also a demand from the public to install an additional furnace," Pal said.

The PCB found that the existing building was too small to accommodate an additional furnace. "There is no vacant space to construct an additional building. The existing electric crematorium is too old and spares are not easily available. The chimney needs urgent replacement and a pollution control system. We decided it is feasible to install two new CNG-based furnaces in the existing building after dismantling the old electric furnace. The furnace is compatible with both CNG and LPG gas," he said.

The crematorium receives at least eight bodies daily, Vijay Chavan, head of the electricity department at PCB, said. The number almost doubled during the Covid pandemic, he added.

After Oxytocin racket bust, police arrest six cattle owners

DAYS AFTER they busted an organised racket of illicit production and sale of Oxytocin to be used for increasing milk production of cattle, the Pune police have arrested six dairy cattle owners who have allegedly used the hormone on their animals.

On November 5, Anti Narcotics Cell of the Pune City Police's Crime Branch busted a large-scale racket of illicit production and sale of Oxytocin after a raid in Lohegaon area in which the hormone was being smuggled. They seized around 290 boxes containing a large number of oxytocin vials and ampoules, worth over Rs 53 lakh in the illicit market. Initially, police arrested five persons running the production unit from a shed in Kalwad Vasti in Lohegaon. The five persons were identified as Sameer Qureshi, a resident of Kalwad Vasti who hails from Meerut in Uttar Pradesh, Bishwajeet Sudhanshu Jana and Mangal Kananlal Giri, both from East Medinipur District in West Bengal, Satyajee Maheshchandra Mondal and Shrimanta Manoranjan Haldar, both from South 24 Parganas District of West Bengal.

The police arrested the alleged mastermind, Allaundh Laskar, from Mumbai in Thane. In the latest development, police have arrested dairy cattle owners who have allegedly used the hormone on their animals. They are Vitthal Zinzurde of Pimple Saudagar, Sagar Saste of Moshi, Vilas Murkute of Marunji, Sunil Malkunaik of Tingare Nagar, Ganesh Pailwan of Gultekdi, and Mahadu Parande of Dighi. They were arrested on November 14 and booked under Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act along with relevant IPC sections pertaining to causing hurt by means of poison, adulteration of food or drink intended for sale among others.

FARMER'S MURDER: KEY SUSPECT ARRESTED IN GUJARAT

Pune: Over eight months after a 38-year-old farmer was hacked to death following a property dispute in Junnar taluka of Pune district, the Pune Rural Police has arrested a key accused in the case from Gujarat. The man had been living under an assumed identity and had altered his looks as well.

Rohidas Baburao Pable was hacked to death behind his house on March 9. While the police arrested seven suspects, a key assailant, Manna Singh, continued to evade arrest. Police received a tip-off that Singh was working in Vadodra under an assumed identity. Police personnel disguised themselves as workers to gather information and confirm the identity of the suspect. They arrested Singh on Sunday. He was produced before court on Tuesday and remanded to police custody for five days. ENS
