7 YRS SINCE BIHAR LIQUOR BAN

199 deaths, 30 hooch cases but no conviction yet: Bihar Police data

A TOTAL of 199 official hooch deaths (if suspected hooch deaths are included, the toll goes up to 269) have been recorded and 30 cases lodged since 2016, when the anti-liquor law came into force, but no one person has been convicted so far.

Thirteen people who were convicted in March 2021 in the 2016 Gopalganj hooch deaths case by a lower court were acquitted by the Patna High Court in July last year for "lack of corroborative evidence".

This is the gist of 10-page internal list of Bihar Police on spurious liquor death cases from 2016 till 2023. The list does not include the latest East Champaran case in which 26 people have died so far after consuming illicit liquor.

This is the first time the state police headquarters has prepared a cumulative list of seven years with status of all 30 cases, including 10 in which 10 or more people died because of consumption of illicit liquor. The state police list showed that 2022 saw the maximum of 114 deaths, followed by 64 deaths in 2021.

The list confirms 42 deaths in Saran in December 2022. It also puts "72" as total suspected deaths in the list. The National

Human Rights Commission in its recent inquiry report on Saran had put the "total deaths at 72", pulling up the state government for "under-reporting" spurious liquor deaths.

The state police's status report on investigation into 30 spurious liquor death cases shows that 29 probes have not reached a logical end. Chargesheets have been filed in 22 cases against 40 persons.

Even though Nitish boasted of speedy trial in liquor cases, the police status report does not give any such hint. Seven major cases lodged between April 2021 and April 2022 are at the stage of recording of witnesses and framing of charges. These include April 2021 Nawada case (21 deaths), July 2021 Lauria, West Champaran, (12 deaths), November 2021 Nautan, West Champaran, (10 deaths), November 2021 Mahmadpur, Gopalganj, (10 deaths) and January 2022 Sohsarai, Nalanda, (12 deaths).

While the latest police report does not mention status of over-all liquor cases, other police reports say that over 3.75 lakh cases have been lodged under the liquor law with over 4.25 lakh arrests. Over 90 per cent of these cases are related to consumption of liquor. Over 25,000 have been still lodged in 57 jails across the state having capacity to house 57,000 inmates, for violation of the liquor ban.

As violence rages in Sudan, 31 from Karnataka stuck without food, water

THE FIGHT between the military and a powerful paramilitary force in Sudan has left at least 31 people from Karnataka stuck in their houses in Sudanese city of El-Fasher. S Prabhhu, a resident of Channagiri in Karnataka's Davanagere district, told *The Indian Express* over the phone that it has been four-five days that they have stepped outside their home, and frequent bombing and shell attacks are being reported in their neighbourhood.

"We are trapped inside a rented house with no access to food and drinking water facilities. Gunfire and shelling can be heard in the background. Nobody is responding to our problem and we are not sure how we will return to India," he said.

Prabhhu, 36, and his wife Soniya, 27, went to Sudan 10 months ago to sell Ayurvedic products, which

have a significant demand there and in Africa. "We belong to the Hakkli Pikki tribe. There are hundreds of Indians stuck in various places in Sudan. Leaving behind my young kids, my wife and I came here to earn our bread and butter. We did not know that Sudan was having these issues," he said.

"We have not had food for three days. There is a water tank in the residential complex that is beginning to run dry. We have not taken a bath or used water for any other purpose than to drink. A wall of one of the houses in the complex has been hit during the cross-fire," he said.

Prabhhu said five of those stuck are from Channagiri, seven are from Shivamogga, and 19 from Hunsur taluk in Mysore.

Fierce fighting erupted between the military and the country's powerful paramilitary force, Rapid Support Forces, in Khartoum on Saturday, raising fears of a wider conflict in the chaos-stricken country.

2 killed in tiger attacks, curfew in many villages of Uttarakhand

AFTER THE deaths of two elderly men in the past four days, suspected to have been killed by a full-grown tiger, Uttarakhand's Pauri Garhwal district administration has imposed a curfew in more than two dozen villages of Rikhanikhil and Dhumakot tehsils until further orders.

The prohibitory orders will remain in force for 11 hours every day from 7 pm to 6 am. Apart from this, schools and Anganwadis in both the tehsils will remain closed until Tuesday. According to the order issued by Pauri Garhwal District Magistrate (DM) Ashish Kumar Chauhan, the incident has caused panic among local residents, and there is a serious possibility of the tiger attacking again.

After 65-hour questioning, TMC MLA held, 3rd so far

THE CBI arrested Trinamool Congress (TMC) MLA Jiban Krishna Saha after questioning him for more than 65 hours over his alleged links to the West Bengal School Service Commission recruitment scam on Monday - making him the third legislator from the ruling party to be arrested in the case.

"He has been arrested. Some people, including Saha, acted as conduits between the candidates and other accused by promising the aspirants jobs as primary teachers in 2016," said a CBI official, adding that he also tried to tamper digital evidence when the agency searched his premises earlier last week. Saha was brought to Kolkata by road from his residence in Murshidabad district and was then taken to SSKM Hospital for a medical check-up. He was brought to the CBI office at Nizam Palace in Kolkata. After being produced before a special CBI court in Alipore, he was remanded to four days in the agency's custody.

Saha is the TMC MLA from Burwan constituency in Murshidabad district.

TMC chief and West Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee accused the BJP of targeting her party's MLA in a "planned manner".

Before Saha, two other TMC MLAs - Partha Chatterjee and Manik Bhattacharya - were arrested in connection with the scam. Former minister Partha Chatterjee was arrested in July 2022 after piles of cash were recovered from properties linked to his close aide Arpita Mukherjee.

Mamata alleges Shah plot to topple her govt

WEST BENGAL CM Mamata Banerjee on Monday demanded that Union Home Minister Amit Shah should resign from his post for allegedly "conspiring" to topple her government.

Addressing a press conference at the state secretariat, Banerjee said, "On Friday, Amit Shah addressed a rally here. How can the Union Home Minister talk about toppling a democratically elected government of a state? Is the Constitution of the country being changed? Is he drafting a new law? He can never make such a comment that if BJP wins 35 Lok Sabha seats, the state government won't complete the full term."

Banerjee also termed Shah's comments as "undemocratic" and "unconstitutional". Shah had said if BJP gets 35 Lok Sabha seats in state in 2024, the TMC government will collapse by 2025.

Instead of protecting the federal structure of the country, the Union Home Minister is conspiring to topple an elected government, Banerjee said. "Which law of the land allows him to say such things? He has lost the right to remain in the post," she added.

SC stays HC order asking CBI, ED to probe Abhishek

THE SUPREME Court on Monday stayed the Calcutta High Court direction asking the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Enforcement Directorate (ED) to investigate Trinamool Congress (TMC) leader Abhishek Banerjee in connection with the West Bengal school jobs scam.

Fixing the matter for hearing next on April 24, a three-judge bench presided by Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud ordered that "till the next day listing, there shall be a stay of all action against the petitioner in pursuance of the directions contained in the order of the Single Judge".

Appearing for Banerjee, Senior Advocate AM Singhvi objected to the contents of an interview given by the concerned judge to a newspaper and told the bench, also comprising Justices P S Narasimha and J B Pardiwala, that it is yet to be retraced.

The CJ, however, responded that "judges don't go around contradicting something which has appeared in print".

On April 13, the High Court had asked the two probe agencies to investigate Banerjee's alleged role in irregularities in recruitment of teaching and non-teaching staff at government schools.

Addressing a public meeting, Banerjee had said that there was pressure on some of the accused to name him. One of the accused,

Kuntal Ghosh, had subsequently alleged that the investigators were pressuring him to name the TMC leader.

Ordering a probe, the High Court had said: "It is a matter to be enquired and investigated whether Kuntal Ghosh took the cue from the public speech of Abhishek Banerjee for which both of them can be interrogated both by ED and by CBI and such interrogation should be made soon."

Objecting to this, Singhvi said the writ, which was filed before the High Court, has nothing to do with him and that "the directions which were issued by the Single Judge are wholly extraneous to the reliefs, which were sought in the petition and the petitioner is not impleaded as a party in the proceedings".

The High Court order came on a plea by the ED in response to a complaint by Ghosh alleging pressure on him to name Banerjee in the case. The High Court had also ordered that "no police station shall lodge any FIR against any complaint made to it in respect of any officer of CBI and ED who are investigating the educational recruitment scam without the leave of this court".

Delhi HC seeks Centre's reply to plea for linking Aadhaar with properties

THE DELHI High Court on Monday sought Centre's response to a plea seeking linking of immovable and movable property documents of citizens with their Aadhaar numbers to curb corruption, black money generation, and benami transactions.

A division bench of Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma and Justice Yashwant Varma granted four weeks to the ministries of Finance, Law, Housing and Urban Affairs and Rural Development to file their responses.

The bench orally said that "it is a good matter and let replies come", listing the case for hearing on July 18. The plea moved by petitioner and Advocate Ashwini Upadhyay states that it is the duty of the state to take appropriate steps to curb corruption and seize "benami" properties amassed by illegal means to give a strong message that the government is determined to fight corruption and black money generation.

"If the government links property with Aadhaar, it will lead to an increment of two per cent in annual growth. It will clean out the electoral process, which is dominated by black money and benami transactions and thrives on a cycle of large black investments... use of political strength to amass private wealth, all with disdain of the citizen," the plea states.

It further states that linking movable-immovable properties with the owner's Aadhaar would resolve activities associated with benami transactions.

Gujarat AAP leader held over anti-BJP remarks, gets bail

AAM AADMI Party's national joint secretary Gopal Italia was arrested by the Surat Crime Branch in a criminal case over his remarks against Gujarat BJP president CR Paatil during an election campaign in 2022. He was granted bail later from the police station. Inspector LD Vaghadia of Surat crime branch said, "We arrested Gopal Italia in a pending defamation complaint against him. He was later released on bail from crime branch police station."

AAP national convener Arvind Kejriwal said the BJP aims to "finish the Aam Aadmi Party".

Sources in the crime branch said Italia was issued a notice by the Surat wing of the crime branch a few days ago and was asked to be present in the office on Monday afternoon. The former Gujarat AAP chief went to the crime branch office alone after intimidating party leaders and

workers. The officials took his statements before initiating procedures to arrest him.

After being released on bail, Italia said the police action was aimed at harassing him. "Such statements are made by all political leaders against one another. How come an FIR was lodged only against me? They (police and government) are misusing their power," he said.

The complaint was lodged at Umrta police station in Surat by Surat BJP leader Pratap Jirawala, a resident of Varachha, on September 2, 2022, over Italia's alleged defamatory remarks against Paatil through social media platforms. Italia had uploaded the messages after an alleged at-

tack on his colleague Manoj Sorathiya in Surat on August, 2022. Police registered an offence under Indian Penal Code (IPC) sections 469 (forgery for purpose of harming reputation), 500 (punishment for defamation), 501 (1)(b) (printing or engraving matter known to be defamatory), 504 (intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of the peace).

At a rally in Khetri, Jhunjhunu, Pilot mentioned his dharna, saying: "It has been a week but there has been no action." He said when the party sought votes promising action against some people, those

"will have to be fulfilled". "This struggle and resolution for clean politics was strong yesterday, today and will remain strong tomorrow.
