'GOVT CREATED STRONG GST SYSTEM FOR EASE OF LIVING'

Govt didn't introduce any new tax during pandemic, says FM

THE GOVERNMENT did not introduce any new tax during the Covid-19 pandemic and taxes have not been raised even after the pandemic, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Saturday.

"It was his (Prime Minister's) advice that no new tax should be introduced in the name of Covid and we didn't charge people right from vaccines to distribution of food. Not only that, even after Covid-19 pandemic, taxes were not raised," Sitharaman said while speaking at the valedictory session of the National Conclave on nine years of the National Democratic Alliance government.

Referring to reforms taken by the government in areas such as women empowerment, start-

ups, and measures during Covid-19 pandemic, Sitharaman said removal of 1,500 archaic laws was done to ensure that such laws do not become an instrument to harass citizens and a tool for corruption.

Citing the example of Goods and Services Tax (GST), she said, "This government not only brought robust legislation with all states on board, but also created a strong system of GST to provide ease of living to the common and

business people," Sitharaman said.

Referring to the start-up ecosystem, she said closing business was a stigma earlier but with the introduction of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC), young people can start a business and, in case of failure, also close it honourably.

The Finance Minister highlighted the intention of the government through seva, sushashan and garib kalyan, adding that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has brought in a change in the mindset and earned the trust and faith of the people of this country through 'Seva Bhaav'.

"These changes happen when the leadership works with all the stakeholders to change their mindsets. India is a very complex country & decision-making goes through many layers and levels," she said.

Will become \$5-trn economy by 2027: Sunil Mittal

New Delhi: India will be able to become \$5-trillion economy by 2027, Bharti Enterprises founder and Chairman Sunil Mittal said on Saturday.

While speaking at a conclave on 9 years of the Narendra Modi government, Mittal said businesses in general require a very decisive leadership and India af-

ter a long time has a government with full majority.

"This country has clearly moved to an additional \$1.4 trillion taking us to \$3.5 trillion and I think the audacious target of \$5 trillion, which couple of years ago would have looked a difficult one to accomplish, is now clearly in sight and I think by 2027 we should be

able to achieve it," Mittal said. He said that he personally experienced the change in last five years.

Mittal said that India, according to him, is the most advanced country in the world as far as telecom is concerned.

"My generation grew up in the age of very deep and long short-

ages of telecom and connectivity to a point today where the deepest and remotest part of the country is using smartphones.

"We moved very quickly from technology shifts. India now has the fastest 5G roll-out in the world. By 2024 March India will have 5G connectivity across the country," Mittal said. **PTI**

'India to be 4th-largest economy within 2 years'

ENABLING POLICIES and grass-root initiatives of Modi-led government have led to social and economic transformation of the country since 2014, and the nation is all set to become the fourth-largest economy in world within two years, Union minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said on Saturday.

India is being seen as a bright spot globally and the world is placing its confidence in India, Vaishnaw said, urging people to

continue posing their faith in the decisive leadership that will take the nation to new highs by 2027.

After Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led government came to power in 2014, India moved up from tenth rank to the fifth, Vaishnaw said, adding within two years India will be fourth largest economy in world.

"Within six years, India will be the third largest economy in world," Vaishnaw said highlighting the speed of progress and economic growth under the government, which is driven by determination and can-do attitude.

CBIC issues SoPs for scrutiny of GST returns for FY20 onwards

DETAILING THE standard operating procedure (SoP) for scrutiny of tax returns from the financial year 2019-20 onwards under the Goods and Services Tax (GST) regime, the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has stated that the analytics unit will identify returns for scrutiny depending on various risk parameters.

As per the SoP released Friday, selection of returns for scrutiny will be done by the Directorate General of Analytics and Risk Management (DGARM) based on various risk parameters identified by them. DGARM will select the GSTINs registered with the central tax authorities, and the details of GSTINs selected will be made available on the scrutiny dashboard of the concerned Central Tax officer on ACES-GST application.

"The details of the risk parameters, in respect of which risk has been identified for a particular GSTIN, and the amount of tax/discrepancy involved in respect of the concerned risk parameters (i.e. likely revenue implication), will also be shown on the scrutiny dashboard of the proper officer for their convenience," the SoP said. Earlier this month, the CBIC had rolled out a module for automated scrutiny of GST returns. The module enables tax officers to carry out scrutiny of GST returns of Centre-administered taxpayers selected on the basis of data analytics and risks identified by the System.

Amid rising instances of GST frauds and cases of fake invoices, the government has been taking

steps to broaden the compliance mandate for more businesses, especially small and medium enterprises and also help boost the GST revenue collections.

The concerned Central Tax officer will have to conduct scrutiny of returns pertaining to a minimum of 4 GSTINs every month, which would include scrutiny of all returns pertaining to a financial year for which the said GSTIN has been selected for scrutiny.

"As far as possible, scrutiny of return should have minimal interface between the proper officer and the registered person and, there should normally not be any need for seeking documents/records from the registered persons before issuance of Form GST ASMT-10," it added. GST ASMT-10 is a scrutiny notice that a tax officer would send to an assessee. On receipt of such notice in GST ASMT-10 on common portal, the registered person may accept the discrepancy mentioned in the said notice, and pay the tax, interest and any other amount arising from such discrepancy and inform the same or may furnish an explanation for the discrepancy in Form GST ASMT-11, through the common portal, to the proper officer within the specified time period of 30 days, the SoP added.

Abhishek Jain, Partner & National Head - Indirect Tax, KPMG in India said this SoP would bring a uniform and consistent methodology to authorities to perform the scrutiny of returns filed by taxpayers.

"Now businesses should take a proactive step and prepare requisite reconciliations with intact reasons/records to substantiate such differences," he said.

INTERVIEW WITH CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, LANZATECH

'There is enough carbon above ground for us to make everything we need'

US-BASED carbon recycling major LanzaTech likens its technology to a brewery, which uses bacteria to ferment pollution and make ethanol. Unilever has used surfactants made from this ethanol in dishwashing liquids, while Zara has made dresses using yarn made from it. In India, LanzaTech is working with energy companies like Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) and Mangalore Refinery and Petrochemicals (MRPL).

In an interaction with SUKALP SHARMA at the recently-held UAE Climate Tech conference in Abu Dhabi, LanzaTech's chief executive officer JENNIFER HOLMGREN talked about the future of carbon capture and recycling, its potential in India, and challenges of scalability and affordability. Edited excerpts:

In simple terms, what is it that LanzaTech does?

What we do is fermentation. It is just like making beer from sugar, but we don't use sugar. We use gases—carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide, and hydrogen—and we ferment them to produce ethanol. Ethanol has a lot of applications beyond blending with gasoline (petrol). You can make ethanol and use it as an intermediate to make sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) and materials like poly-

ester. In the longer term, we can also make other chemicals and materials. That's the future—the ability to make any product from waste.

There is enough carbon above ground for us to make everything we need.

How scalable are technologies like carbon capture and recycling and waste-to-energy?

They are scalable but you have to think differently. In petroleum, you get economies of scale by building as big a refinery as possible. But in this case, you have to think of a distributed model. Suppose you want to use agricultural residue to make ethanol. You don't want to collect it from

all over and take it to one or few large plants. Instead, you want units where the waste is. It involves decentralisation and it is a lot like solar. You can put a small solar unit for village without needing large transmission infrastructure. This decentralised approach also ensures local supply chains, jobs to locals, and some amount of energy autonomy to them. While India is not an oil-rich country, you have enough carbon.

How do you see carbon capture and recycling evolving for India over the next five to 10 years?

I hope that a significant fraction of India's carbon portfolio will be from local resources.

Sun Pharma proposes to acquire Israel's Taro

New Delhi: Sun Pharmaceutical Industries on Saturday said it has proposed to fully acquire Israel-based Taro Pharmaceutical Industries through a reverse triangular merger.

The Mumbai-based drug major said it has issued a letter to the Taro board with a proposal con-

taining a non-binding indication of interest to acquire all of the outstanding ordinary shares for a purchase price of \$38 per ordinary share in cash. Sun Pharma currently owns a 78.48 per cent stake in Taro.

"We envisage the proposed transaction to be consummated

in the form of a reverse triangular merger under the Israeli Companies Law, 1999 and practice," Sun Pharma said in a regulatory filing.

The purchase price represents a premium of 31.2 per cent over Taro's closing price on May 25, 2023, a 41.5 per cent premium

over Taro's average closing price in the last 60 days and a compelling liquidity opportunity for Taro's shareholders, it added.

Under the indicative proposal, post the acquisition, Taro will become a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sun Pharma and will be delisted from NYSE. **PTI**

PSUs' dividends worth at least \$300 mn stuck in Russia: Why?

DIVIDEND INCOME of public sector oil companies—ONGC Videsh (OVL), Oil India (OIL), Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) and Bharat PetroResources (BPRL)—from their investments in Russian projects, totalling at well over \$300 million, are stuck in that country, parked in an Indian bank there.

The reason? Payment channel-related issues in the aftermath of Russia's February 2022 invasion of Ukraine. Soon after the war in Ukraine broke out, a number of major Russian banks were banned from the Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication (SWIFT) financial transaction processing

system, seriously constricting Moscow's ability to access the global payments system. In addition, the Russian government has put curbs on repatriation of dollars in a bid to keep exchange rate volatility in check.

The companies, which have invested billions of dollars in Russian oil assets, are now in a huddle to consider options to repatriate or access and use that money. But, it may not be that simple.

India's investment in Russian oil assets

Over the years, Indian public sector companies have picked up stakes in producing oil and gas projects in Russia, spending billions of dollars in the process. One estimate pegs the overall invest-

ment close to \$6 billion. These investments are part of India's energy security strategy as the country is heavily dependent on energy imports. A long-standing strategic partnership between India and Russia has been a significant factor in these deals.

OVL, the overseas investment arm of Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC), holds a 20 per cent stake in the Sakhalin-1 project and 26 per cent in Vankorneft field. It also owns Imperial Energy, which has fields in Siberia. The consortium of IOC, OIL, and Bharat Petroleum Corporation's (BPCL's) upstream arm BPRL has 23.9 per cent share in Vankorneft and 29.9 per cent in

Taas-Yuryakh Neftegazodobychna fields.

Dividend income stuck in Russia

While Indian companies were receiving regular dividend income from their investments in Russia prior to Moscow's February 2022 invasion of Ukraine, they have not been able to repatriate dividend income since the war broke out. To be sure, Russian companies operating the projects are releasing dividends to their Indian partners, but the money is piling up in the Commercial Indo Bank (CIBL) in Russia and the Indian companies are earning some interest on it as well. CIBL used to be a joint-venture of SBI and Canara Bank, but the latter re-

cently sold its stake in the venture to SBI.

The consortium of IOC, OIL, and BPRL has around \$300 million in unpaid dividends parked in CIBL. Dividends belonging to OVL are also piling up. In April, a top government official had said that dividends stuck in Russia were estimated at around \$400 million at the time. But the actual sum could be even higher. There is no official data available for dividend income parked in CIBL.

The options, or a lack thereof

India and Russia have been discussing the issue on a regular basis and efforts are on from both sides to resolve it, said a senior government official.

मुंबई : मुंबई महानगरपालिकेने 'मिठी नदी जल गुणवत्ता सुधार' प्रकल्प हाती घेतला असून या प्रकल्पाअंतर्गत मिठी नदीतील काही लाख लिटर पाण्याची गुणवत्ता वृद्धिंगत करून ते पुन्हा नदीत सोडण्यात येत आहे. या प्रकल्पामुळे मिठी नदीतील पाण्याची गुणवत्ता सुधारत असल्याचा दावा मुंबई महानगरपालिकेकडून करण्यात आला आहे. दरम्यान, पाण्याच्या गुणवत्तेत सुधारणा झाल्यामुळे मिठी नदीत काही ठिकाणी मासे दिसू लागले आहेत, असाही दावा महानगरपालिकेकडून करण्यात आला आहे.

महानगरपालिका आयुक्त इम्बाल सिंह चहल आणि अतिरिक्त महानगरपालिका आयुक्त (प्रकल्प) पी. वेलरासू यांच्या मार्गदर्शानुसार 'मिठी नदी जल गुणवत्ता सुधार' प्रकल्प राबविण्यात येत आहे. मुंबईतच उगम पावणाऱ्या आणि मुंबईतच समुद्राला जाऊन मिळणाऱ्या मिठी नदीची एकूण लांबी १७.८४ किलोमीटर इतकी आहे. या नदीचे पाणलोट क्षेत्र साधारणपणे ७ हजार २१५ हेक्टर एवढे आहे. संजय गांधी राष्ट्रीय उद्यानातील विहार आणि पर्वई तलावांमधून होणारा विस्मग हा या नदीचा प्रमुख

दररोज ८० लाख लिटर क्षमतेचा प्रकल्प कार्यरत

अशी होते सांडपाण्यावर प्रक्रिया

■ प्रकल्पापर्यंत आणलेल्या पाण्यावर प्राथमिक, द्वितीय आणि तृतीय अशा प्रक्रिया होतात. प्राथमिक प्रक्रियेत सांडपाण्यासोबत आलेला कचरा वेगळा केला जातो. द्वितीय प्रक्रियेत पाण्यातील धारू किंवा अन्य प्रकारचे सूक्ष्म कण वेगळे केले जाते. तृतीय प्रक्रियेत पाण्यातील दूषितपणा आणि दुर्गंधी दूर केली जाते. त्यानंतर अतिनील किरणांच्या मदतीने शुद्धीकरणाची प्रक्रिया पूर्णत्वास नेली जाते. शुद्ध झालेले पाणी पुन्हा मिठी नदीत सोडले जाते.

■ 'मिठी नदी जल गुणवत्ता सुधारणा' प्रकल्प पर्वई क्षेत्रात कार्यरत आहे. यामध्ये फिल्टरपाडाचा परिसर, मोरारजी नगर आणि मिठी नदीचा भाग येतो. या भागातून येणाऱ्या सांडपाण्यावर प्रक्रिया करून या प्रकल्पामध्ये पाणी शुद्ध करून ते पुन्हा मिठी नदीमध्ये सोडले जाते.



जलस्रोत आहे. ही नदी माहिमच्या खाडीतून समुद्राला जाऊन मिळते. मुंबईमध्ये २६ जुलै २००५ रोजी आलेल्या प्रलयंकारी पावसांनंतर पूर्णस्थिती हाताळण्याच्या उद्देशाने मुख्यमंत्र्यांच्या अध्यक्षतेखाली मिठी नदी विकास आणि संरक्षण प्राधिकरणाची (एमआरडीपीए) १९ ऑगस्ट २००५ रोजी स्थापना करण्यात आली. त्यानंतर केंद्रीय जल आणि ऊर्जा संशोधन केंद्र (सीडब्ल्यूपीआरएस) आणि सत्यशोधन समितीच्या

शिफारसीनुसार दोन टप्प्यांमध्ये मिठी नदीचे रुंदीकरण, खोलीकरण, संरक्षण भित्त व सेवा रस्ता बांधण्याचे काम हाती घेण्यात आले होते. यातील बहुतांश कामे पूर्ण झाली आहेत.

एकेकाळी वाहती आणि समृद्ध नदी म्हणून ओळख असणारी मिठी कालांतराने घनकचरा, सांडपाणी, अतिक्रमण आदी समस्यांनी ग्रसली गेली आणि या नदीच्या अस्तित्वावर प्रश्नचिन्ह निर्माण झाले होते. संफेद पूल नाला, मरोळ बापट नाला आणि

तलासरी, डहाणूला पुन्हा भूकंपाचे धक्के

डहाणू : पालघर जिल्ह्यातील डहाणू आणि तलासरी तालुका पुन्हा एकदा भूकंपाने हादरले. शनिवारी सायंकाळी तलासरी आणि डहाणू तालुक्यात लागोपाट दोन भूकंपाचे हादरे बसले.

पहिल्या धक्क्याचा केंद्रबिंदू तलासरी तालुक्यातील घाटणे येथे, तर दुसरा धक्का डहाणू तालुक्यातील कांकरवाडी येथे बसला. दोनही ठिकाणी हे धक्के साधारण २० सेकंदांपर्यंत जाणवले. पहिला धक्का ५.१५ वाजता ३.३ रिश्टर स्केल तीव्रतेचा होता. भूगर्भात ८ किलोमीटरवर त्याचा केंद्रबिंदू होता. दुसरा धक्का ५.२८ वाजता बसला. त्याची तीव्रता ३.५ रिश्टर स्केल आणि केंद्रबिंदू भूगर्भात ५ किलोमीटरवर होता.

पालघरमधील डहाणू आणि तलासरी तालुक्यात २०१८ पासून भूकंपाचे धक्के बसत आहेत. या वर्षी जानेवारी नंतर २७ मे रोजी लागोपाट दोन भूकंपाचे हादरे जाणवले. पुन्हा सुरू झालेल्या भूकंपाच्या हादऱ्यांमुळे परिसरात भीतीचे वातावरण आहे.

ट्राम्बे, माहुल येथील रेल्वेच्या हद्दीतील अतिक्रमणांवर कारवाई

मुंबई : मध्य रेल्वे प्रशासनाने रेल्वेच्या जमिनीवरील अतिक्रमण हटाविण्याची मोहीम हाती घेतली असून ट्राम्बे आणि माहुल भागातील रेल्वेच्या हद्दीत अतिक्रमण करून उभारलेली आठ दुकाने, तीन झोपडपसंहे तीन स्टील कंटेनरवर मध्य रेल्वेने कारवाई केली.

मध्य रेल्वेच्या हद्दीत मोठ्या संख्येने अनधिकृत झोपडपसंहे उभ्या राहिल्या आहेत. परिणामी, रेल्वेचा विकासात्मक कामे करण्यास अडचण येत आहे. ही बाब लक्षात घेऊन मध्य रेल्वेने रेल्वे जमिनीवरील अतिक्रमण हटाविण्याची मोहीम हाती घेतली आहे, अशी माहिती मध्य रेल्वे प्रशासनाने दिली.
