IT MINISTER'S COMMENTS COME AHEAD OF LS POLLS

Vaishnav flags influence of social media on democracy

FLAGGING CONCERNS REGARDING the "influence" that social media platforms can have on democratic processes, Union minister of communications, IT and railways Ashwini Vaishnav said that while India currently has a regulatory framework that can deal with the issue to an extent, a "much more comprehensive legal structure" was needed.

Speaking at The Indian Express Idea Exchange event on Tuesday, Vaishnav also emphasised that the context in which legal immunity from third party content — or "safe harbour" protection — was offered to social media platforms has "changed", and there is a need for these platforms to be subjected to increased accountability.

Vaishnav's comments are significant as India heads towards general elections over the next few months.

"All over the world, democracies are worried about the influence of social media on democratic processes. Especially after the developments around Artificial Intelligence (AI), people are really concerned about their impact on

democracies," Vaishnav said. "The promise of social media was that everybody gets a voice, a platform on which opinions can be expressed and it was not like traditional media where editorial control can keep some opinions out. That promise had an inherent understanding that whoever is publishing views on social media would also be accountable for it, be cognisant of the legal structure, social realities and ensure that nobody else is hurt. Unfortunately, that part has deteriorated over a period of time, and today's social media has become a free-for-all where anyone can write anything derogatory about anybody else," he said.

Vaishnav said a number of countries have had to take steps to contain the problem, and India faces a similar challenge. "We are also facing that challenge. We have a legal structure which addresses

some of the concerns to some extent, but, definitely, we need a much stronger and much more comprehensive legal structure. There has to be some judgement on what is right and wrong. There has to be some sort of accountability, both of the platforms and users," he said.

Highlighting that social media platforms today follow their own content moderation policies and also deploy algorithms that dictate the prominence content pieces get, Vaishnav questioned whether "safe harbour" should continue to exist in the way it was originally envisaged.

"Earlier, the context (for safe harbour) was that the Internet was emerging, it was totally new. It was starting to come out of laboratories and universities to the general public. At the time, the people who wanted to take the Internet to the public sought to

limit their liability for content for which they were not responsible," Vaishnav said.

"Today, the context has completely changed. Which platform doesn't moderate content today? Every platform does it. They do it according to their own wishes, it is not as per the law, but according to their own policies. The investment they make in content moderation is different in different geographies, depending on their own priorities," he said.

He also questioned whether the use of algorithms to distribute content on social media platforms was "equitable".

"Once you say an algorithm will decide what is going to be seen, is that equitable? It is not equitable. You are not actually seeing what you want to see, you are consuming the content which the algorithm wants you to consume. It is not a mere chance that you are getting a video which you thought you should see. It is a pure mathematical algorithm which is defining your life today," he said.

"So, when the platform is no longer a platform in the true sense, should the safe harbour be a safe harbour in the original sense? That's my question," Vaishnav added.

Several bright spots amid slowdown in farm exports

SEVERAL RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED on rice exports to improve domestic supplies have adversely impacted India's farm exports in the first eight months of current fiscal. However, shipments of Basmati rice (18%), buffalo meat (13%) and fresh fruits and vegetables (20%) have grown significantly even amid the general slump in shipments.


Exports of agricultural items and processed foods, which had remained resilient in the last few fiscal years, dropped by 10% to \$15.72 billion during the April-November period of the current fiscal on year.

The value of cereals exports in the first eight months of 2023-24 dropped sharply by 8% to \$6.44 billion on year because of the ban on white and broken rice exports, shipment duties on parboiled rice and the ban on wheat exports imposed in May last year.

According to the Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics, while basmati rice exports grew 18% in

April-November of FY24 to \$3.37 billion, non-basmati rice shipment declined sharply by 25% to \$3.07 billion this fiscal compared to previous year.

In terms of volume, rice exports dropped by 25% to 10.68 million tonne (MT) in April-November period of the current fiscal mainly due to a 34% fall in the volume of non-basmati rice shipment to 7.69 MT on year. India has been the largest rice exporter since 2012 and till this fiscal had around 40-45% share in the global trade.

The shipment of all other major items — buffalo meat, fresh fruits and vegetables and other processed products such as groundnut, in the agricultural and processed food products exports development authority (APEDA) basket, rose significantly in the current fiscal.

Buffalo meat exports rose to \$2.4 billion in this fiscal compared to the same period last year. The exports of fresh fruits and vegetables have risen 20% in the first eight months of FY24 to \$1.18 billion on year. Groundnut shipment rose 17%

to \$0.5 billion so far on year. "We are aiming to expand the market for several agricultural products such as bananas, mangoes, processed fruits and juices, fruits and vegetables seeds and processed vegetables exports," a commerce ministry official told FE.

The exports of products under the APEDA basket grew 9% to \$26.3 billion in 2022-23 as compared to FY22, due to a spike in shipment of rice, fruits and vegetables, livestock and dairy products.

The exports of products under APEDA basket was around 50% of the country's total agricultural goods exports of more than \$53.2 billion last fiscal.

Rest of agricultural products exports include marine, tobacco, coffee and tea.

During the August-October period in the current fiscal, the government had imposed a temporary minimum export price (MEP) of \$1,200/tonne on basmati rice shipment to restrict 'illegal shipment of white non-basmati rice in the garb of premium basmati rice.' Subsequently, MEP was reduced to \$950/tonne.

Court allows NewsClick HR head to turn approver

A DELHI COURT has allowed NewsClick Human Resources department head Amit Chakraborty to turn approver in a case filed under the stringent Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) against the news portal.

Additional Sessions Judge Hardeep Kaur of Patiala House Courts also granted him pardon to Chakraborty in the case. Chakraborty had moved an application in the court last month, seeking permission to turn approver in the case and expressing willingness to disclose information to Delhi Police, which is investigating the matter.

NewsClick has been accused of acting with the intention to disrupt the sovereignty and territorial integrity of India and to cause "disaffection" against India.

In August, the Delhi Police Special Cell registered an FIR under sections of the UAPA and the Indian Penal Code against NewsClick founder-editor Prabir Purkayastha and Chakraborty. Both were arrested in October.

Among the allegations in the FIR against Purkayastha were attempts to show Kashmir and Arunachal Pradesh as "not parts of India", discrediting the government's fight against Covid, funding the farmers' agitation, and "putting up a spirited defence of legal cases" against Chinese telecom companies such as Xiaomi and Vivo.

In a statement, NewsClick had termed the allegations "absurd" and said the proceedings initiated against it were "a blatant attempt to muzzle the free and independent press in India".

Purkayastha and Chakraborty were arrested following day-long searches at more than 50 locations linked to the news portal, its employees and contributors. After the searches, the police said 46 "suspects" had been questioned and their "digital devices" seized.

In its remand application, the Special Cell stated that there were "secret inputs" that "foreign funds in crores have been infused illegally into India by Indian and foreign entities inimical to India in pursuance of conspiracy with the intention to disrupt sovereignty and territorial integrity of India, to cause disaffection against India and to threaten the unity, integrity, security of India".

Refiners to ask for extra Saudi oil after price cut

TWO STATE refiners are seeking to boost imports of Saudi crude oil after the kingdom cut the official selling price of its key export grade for February to the lowest in 27 months, company sources said.

Indian Oil, the country's top refiner, and Bharat Petroleum, are looking at lifting an additional 1 million barrels of oil each from Saudi Aramco in February, the sources said.

Saudi Aramco typically notifies Asian buyers of their monthly crude allocations by the 10th of every month.

Indian oil companies and Saudi Aramco did not immediately respond to Reuters emails seeking comments.

IOC is seeking more oil from Saudi Arabia and West Africa partly as it is facing problems in buying Russian light sweet crude Sokol because of challenges in payments, one of the sources said.

India, the world's third-biggest oil importer and consumer, has been gorging on Russian crude, sold at a discount after western nations shunned purchases from Moscow.

That led to Russia becoming top oil supplier to India,



knocking Iraq and Saudi Arabia to second and third place, data obtained from trade sources showed.

Washington last month sanctioned ships and vessel operators for the sale of Russian oil at above the \$60-per barrel cap set by the Group of Seven nations and tightened rules, including heightened scrutiny by banks and service providers to ensure that cargoes do not breach the price cap.

Following the sanctions, several tankers meant to deliver Sokol crude to India have been diverted in the past two months

depressing India's Russian oil imports in December to an 11-month low.

Oil minister Hardeep Singh Puri recently said that the decline in India's import of Russian oil was due to unattractive prices and not payment issues.

IOC used to receive 6-7 cargoes of Sokol oil every month under its annual deal with Rosneft.

The refiner may ask for additional supplies under its term deals with West African producers Nigeria and Angola to make up for loss in Russian oil supply, the source said.

Karnataka HC suspends mining around Krishna Raja Sagar Dam

THE KARNATAKA HIGH COURT has suspended all mining licenses for stone quarrying within a 20-km radius of the Krishna Raja Sagar (KRS) Dam in the Mysore-Mandya region of the state under provisions of the Dam Safety Act, 2021, stating that "the constitutional courts cannot turn a Nelson's Eye to the possible danger/damage posed to the dam of this size".

The high court issued the order Monday in a petition filed by a mining license holder, CG Kumar, against the suspension of his licence by the Mandya deputy commissioner over concerns for the safety of the KRS Dam. The HC converted the petition into a PIL.

"All mining licenses/leases comprising any area (whether in private land, government land or otherwise) that lies within a radius of 20 km from the periphery of the KRS Dam are hereby kept under suspended animation, and as a consequence, no mining or allied activities shall be carried on or continued by any person or agency till after a decision is taken by the statutory committee constituted under the provisions of Dam Safety Act, 2021..." the HC said on Monday.

The suspension of mining licenses will apply to all licenses awarded "prior to the date on which the Dam Safety Act,

2021 came into force ie, 30.12.2021," and even to instances where mining is being carried out on orders of the court or jurisdictional authorities.

"The Authorities such as, the Officials of dept. of mines & geology, police dept, revenue dept, etc shall enforce the above directions in letter & spirit and criminal cases be filed against the violators. The violation of the said directions shall also be liable to be treated as the contempt of this court," the HC bench comprising Chief Justice PB Varale and Justice Krishna Dixit has ruled.

The state government informed the HC that at least six months would be required for a scientific study on the potential damage to the dam because of mining activities which involve blasting of explosives at stone quarries.

"It is a matter left to the expert domain and therefore we are not inclined to fix any specific time frame for accomplishing the task," the HC said.

High Court stays demolition order of property owned by Anil Parab's aide

INA relief to "close associate" of Shiv Sena (UBT) leader and MLC Anil Parab, the Bombay High Court recently stayed a demolition order issued by the additional collector against a resort at Khed in Ratnagiri district owned by Sadanand Gangaram Kadam.

The HC noted that the order passed on the complaint of a person who ceased to become a partner in a firm called Sai Star Distributors, floated by petitioner Sadanand Gangaram Kadam and others, was "innocuous" and the facts in the case were "prima facie shocking". A single-judge bench of Justice Milind N Jadhav was on January 5 hearing a plea by Kadam challenging the December 6, 2023 demolition notice.

Representing Kadam, advocates Shardul Singh and Prerna Gandhi submitted that the dispute began when the property at Khed was purchased on February 8, 2007 by five partners of the firm, two of them were Kadam and one Vijay Bhosale.

Singh submitted that through a consent award from May 2017, the dispute between the partners was settled, Bhosale retired from the firm and Kadam was entitled to the land in question. Bhosale never challenged the consent award, therefore it became final, Kadam argued.

In light of this, Kadam sent an application to the sub-divisional officer seeking permission to grant non-agricultural (NA) status for the property. He obtained this permission on August 3, 2021. Thereafter, he developed a resort on the said land based on further approvals.

On October 26, 2023, Kadam received a show-cause notice from the Additional Collector on

the basis of a private complaint filed by Bhosale, who alleged Kadam breached the NA permission. Kadam contested the show-cause notice, however, the Additional Collector on November 24 passed an order revoking the NA permission and set it aside.

Singh said that Kadam had filed a statutory appeal against the same, which is pending, despite repeated requests by Kadam seeking a stay on the revocation order. On December 8, Kadam received a notice for demolition of the construction carried out on the said land, which he challenged before the HC.

"At this stage, it needs to be noted that once the Respondent Bhosale stood retired from the partnership firm and the said land having come to the entitlement of the petitioner by virtue of the consent Award, any such private complaint by Bhosale in respect of the Khed land alleging breach of NA permission granted in favour of the Petitioner was not prima facie maintainable at all, despite which the issue has proceeded further," Justice Jadhav noted.

The judge added that the facts before him were "extremely strong" and "serious" and the HC's intervention was required "so as to ensure that no litigant or party can take advantage of the legal system for granted and file innocuous complaints".

The HC stayed the demolition notice and directed that no coercive steps shall be taken by the concerned authorities against the petitioner's resort. It also directed that no hearing be conducted in Kadam's statutory appeal till further orders.

Seeking affidavits in reply from respondents within two weeks followed by a rejoinder from the petitioner in a week's time, the HC posted the matter for further hearing for February 2.

Mumbai receives unseasonal rain

MULTIPLE POCKETS in western suburbs including Andheri, Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra and Borivali experienced moderate to heavy spell of unseasonal rain on Tuesday night.

According to the India Meteorology Department (IMD), the rainfall is caused due to a low pressure that has developed in the Arabian Sea.

"Since Tuesday afternoon, there has been cloudy weather above Mumbai. The rains started to pick up from late evening and this has caused due to a trough that has formed in the Arabian Sea and has extended between Maharashtra and Gujarat," Sunil Kamble, head of IMD, Mumbai told Express on Tuesday.

"Alongside Mumbai, rainfall may occur in Konkan districts like Raigad, Ratnagiri and from Wednesday there might be a dip

State cabinet likely to approve urban centres for malnourished kids

THE MAHARASHTRA cabinet on Wednesday will likely clear a proposal to set up urban child development centres (UCDC) for children suffering from severe acute malnutrition (SAM). The centre will be on the lines of similar units functional only in rural areas.

Under this scheme, newborn babies will be tested at the sganwadi level to categorise them as SAM. The infant, if affected by any disease, will be taken to urban body run hospitals, primary health centres, health dispensaries or maternity homes run by Public Health department or by Medical Education department.

years who are not afflicted by any disease will be admitted to the UCDCs. Here, the children will be given energy-dense nutritious food based on guidelines set by UNICEF and WHO. A child development project officer (urban) will be the coordination official for the same. Under this project, the concerned local body's medical officer will visit the UCDCs for tests on SAM children.

Anganwadi workers will also measure the weights of SAM children in front of their parents. Based on this, they will be categories as normal, MAM and SAM. The SAM child can be admitted to a UCDC for a maximum of 12 weeks. The government has estimated a total annual expenditure of Rs 11.51 crore for the scheme, which will be run entirely through state budget.
