High Court stays demolition order of property owned by Anil Parab's aide

INA relief to "close associate" of Shiv Sena (UBT) leader and MLC Anil Parab, the Bombay High Court recently stayed a demolition order issued by the additional collector against a resort at Khed in Ratnagiri district owned by Sadanand Gangaram Kadam.

The HC noted that the order passed on the complaint of a person who ceased to become a partner in a firm called Sai Star Distributors, floated by petitioner Sadanand Gangaram Kadam and others, was "innocuous" and the facts in the case were "prima facie shocking".

A single-judge bench of Justice Milind N Jadhav was on January 5 hearing a plea by Kadam challenging the December 6, 2023 demolition notice.

Representing Kadam, advocates Shardul Singh and Prerna Gandhi submitted that the dispute began when the property at Khed was purchased on February 8, 2007 by five partners of the firm, two of them were Kadam and one Vijay Bhosale.

Singh submitted that through a consent award from May 2017, the dispute between the partners was settled. Bhosale retired from the firm and Kadam was entitled to the land in question. Bhosale never challenged the consent award, therefore it became final, Kadam argued.

In light of this, Kadam sent an application to the sub divisional officer seeking permission to grant non-agricultural (NA) status for the property. He obtained this permission on August 3, 2021. Thereafter, he developed a resort on the said land based on further approvals.

On October 26, 2023, Kadam received a show-cause notice from the Additional Collector on

the basis of a private complaint filed by Bhosale, who alleged Kadam breached the NA permission. Kadam contested the show-cause notice, however, the Additional Collector on November 24 passed an order revoking the NA permission and set it aside.

Singh said that Kadam had filed a statutory appeal against the same, which is pending, despite repeated requests by Kadam seeking a stay on the revocation order. On December 8, Kadam received a notice for demolition of the construction carried out on the said land, which he challenged before the HC.

"At this stage, it needs to be noted that once the Respondent Bhosale stood retired from the partnership firm and the said land having come to the entitlement of the petitioner by virtue of the consent Award, any such private complaint by Bhosale in respect of the Khed land alleging breach of NA permission granted in favour of the Petitioner was not prima facie maintainable at all, despite which the issue has proceeded further," Justice Jadhav noted.

The judge added that the facts before him were 'extremely strong' and 'serious' and the HC's intervention was required "so as to ensure that no litigant or party can take advantage of the legal system for granted and file innocuous complaints".

The HC stayed the demolition notice and directed that no coercive steps shall be taken by the concerned authorities against the petitioner's resort. It also directed that no hearing be conducted in Kadam's statutory appeal till further orders.

Seeking affidavits in reply from respondents within two weeks followed by a rejoinder from the petitioner in a week's time, the HC posted the matter for further hearing for February 2.

Mumbai receives unseasonal rain

MULTIPLE POCKETS in western suburbs including Andheri, Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra and Borivali experienced moderate to heavy spell of unseasonal rain on Tuesday night.

According to the India Meteorology Department (IMD), the rainfall is caused due to a low pressure that has developed in the Arabian Sea.

"Since Tuesday afternoon, there has been cloudy weather above Mumbai. The rains started to pick up from late evening and this has caused due to a trough that has formed in the Arabian Sea and has extended between Maharashtra and Gujarat," Sunil Kamble, head of IMD, Mumbai told Express on Tuesday.

"Alongside Mumbai, rainfall may occur in Konkan districts like Raigad, Ratnagiri and from Wednesday there might be a dip

rains for districts in Marathwada and western Maharashtra.

State cabinet likely to approve urban centres for malnourished kids

THE MAHARASHTRA cabinet on Wednesday will likely clear a proposal to set up urban child development centres (UCDC) for children suffering from severe acute malnutrition (SAM). The centre will be on the lines of similar units functional only in rural areas.

Under this scheme, newborn babies will be tested at the sganwadi level to categorise them as SAM. The infant, if affected by any disease, will be taken to urban body run hospitals, primary health centres, health dispensaries or maternity homes run by Public Health department or by Medical Education department.

SAM children between the age groups of six months and six

years who are not afflicted by any disease will be admitted to the UCDCs. Here, the children will be given energy-dense nutritious food based on guidelines set by UNICEF and WHO. A child development project officer (urban) will be the coordination official for the same. Under this project, the concerned local body's medical officer will visit the UCDCs for tests on SAM children.

Anganwadi workers will also measure the weights of SAM children in front of their parents. Based on this, they will be categories as normal, MAM and SAM. The SAM child can be admitted to a UCDC for a maximum of 12 weeks. The government has estimated a total annual expenditure of Rs 11.51 crore for the scheme, which will be run entirely through state budget.

1. As per Rule 3, Rule 6(3) & Rule 7 of Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules 2006 (Amendments) and pursuant to the directions of the Government, Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA) is inviting applications from the eligible Karnataka candidates for **"Common Entrance Test-2024"** for the purpose of determining the eligibility / merit, for admission to the First year or First semester of full time courses for Government share of seats in Engineering, Technology, Naturopathy & Yoga, B. Pharma, 2nd year B.Pharm and Pharma-D, Agriculture courses (Farm Science), Veterinary and B.Sc. (Nursing) courses, in Government / University / Private Aided / Private Un-Aided Professional Educational Institutions in the State of Karnataka for the academic year 2024-25 as per the seat matrix to be notified by Government.

2. In order to become eligible to obtain admission through KEA to the above mentioned professional courses, a candidate must register for **CET-2024**, fill the application through online, pay the application fees, download the admission ticket and appear for the Common Entrance Test-2024 conducted by KEA, Bangalore. There will be no physical verification as this is application-cum-verification module. The candidates are advised to fill all the details carefully and upload the necessary documents.

COMPULSORY: Application is common to the seat allotment of all professional courses viz., Engineering, Architecture, Naturopathy & Yoga, Veterinary, B. Pharma, 2nd year B.Pharm and Pharma-D, Farm Science courses [B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B.Sc. (Hons.) Sericulture etc.,] and B.Sc. (Nursing), Medical, Dental, Ayurveda, Unani, Homoeopathy, B.P.T., B.Sc. Allied Health Sciences, BPO courses. Candidates should also mandatorily register themselves for CET-2024, fill the application through online and pay the application fees. Please note that for registration to these courses, portal will not be enabled again. **After UGNEET 2024 results are announced, already registered candidates with KEA will be provided interface to enter their NEET score and Roll Number.**

3. For admission to **Medical or Dental or Ayurveda or Unani or Homoeopathy** courses, Karnataka and non-Karnataka candidates must compulsorily register and get qualified in **UGNEET-2024** (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) exam conducted by National Testing Agency. But for admissions through KEA, the candidates have to compulsorily register, submit the application and pay the fees for CET-2024.

4. For admission to **Architecture** course, candidates should appear and get qualified in **NATA-2024** (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) conducted by the Council of Architecture. But for admissions through KEA, the candidates have to compulsorily register, submit the application and pay the fees for CET-2024.

5. As per Government order No. MED 51 RGU 2023 dated 13-04-2023 for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing) courses, Karnataka and non-Karnataka candidates have to appear for Common Entrance Test conducted by KEA. **The non-Karnataka candidates will not be eligible for admission to engineering stream courses through KEA and they will also be not eligible for reservation.**

6. For admission to **B.P.T., B.Sc. Allied Health Sciences, BPO courses**, Karnataka candidates have to compulsorily register, submit the application and pay the fees for CET-2024, but candidates need not appear for **CET-2024**.

Before registering through online for admission to any Professional courses in the state of Karnataka, applicants are hereby informed to read the Information Bulletin and understand the eligibility conditions, classification of seats (different types of category of seats) and eligibility to claim such seats.

Eligibility: As per Rule 5(1) of Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules 2006 (Amendments), No candidate shall be eligible for admission to Government Seats unless he is a citizen of India and satisfies any one of the eligibility conditions specified therein. The candidates who do not satisfy any of the Clauses / Eligibility Criteria are not eligible for admission to professional courses under Government quota seats through KEA. Eligibility for OCI / PIO candidates for Government seats shall be as per the directions of the Government.

7. UGCET-2024-Information Bulletin consisting of details about mode of submission of application through online, eligibility clauses, academic eligibility criteria etc will be hosted on the KEA Website for the information of the candidates. Candidates can download the same from KEA Website. Candidates have to apply online for admission to various Professional Courses through KEA.
