AFTER CONTRACTOR'S SUICIDE Documents show Rs 35k cr needed for Jal Jeevan Mission; parties trade charges

Harshal Patil allegedly died by suicide in Sangli over non-payment of dues of Rs 1.4 crore

EVER SINCE Maharashtra's ruling and opposition parties exchanged barbs after the suicide of young contractor Harshal Patil, allegedly over non-payment of dues amounting to Rs 1.4 crore in account of Jal Jeevan Mission work in Sangli district, documents from the Maharashtra government's Water Supply and Sanitation Department show that the state needs Rs 35,622 crore to complete the ongoing work and honour the dues for the year 2025-26.

As per the data, Maharashtra's annual plan for the year 2025-26 is of Rs 35,622 crore, of which Rs 19,259 crore is Centre's share and Rs 16,363 crore is the share of the state. Meanwhile, the Centre has already conveyed to the state government that it won't be releasing Jal Jeevan Mission funds for the year 2025-26.

Earlier this month, The Indian Express reported that the Maharashtra Government informed the Legislative Council that it has not received central funds for the Jal Jeevan Mission scheme since October 2024 and has been using funds from the state's coffers to complete the ongoing projects.

It also stated that 51,558 schemes have been sanctioned under the mission, of which 26,009 are still ongoing.

However, in a written reply submitted to the Legislative Council, Maharashtra's Water Supply and Sanitation Department informed that the state government has disbursed funds worth Rs 2,483.58 crore to complete the ongoing schemes.

"We are corresponding with the central government to release funds at the earliest. To ensure that ongoing works are not stopped for the year 2025-26, we have decided to give additional funds worth Rs 3,913 crore," Meghana Sakore-Bordikar, Minister of State, had informed. Earlier, a day after 35-year-old Harshal Patil committed suicide over non-payment of his dues worth Rs 1.4 crore, Maharashtra's Water Supply and Sanitation Minister Gulabrao Patil claimed that there are no records of pending dues of the said person.

Harshal's cousin Akshay Patil told police that the contractor worked with immense financial stress. "His bills worth Rs 1.4 crore were pending and he had also taken loan from money lenders. His financial stress was immense and he used to talk about the same for days," said Patil.

According to his relatives, Harshal left home on Tuesday and did not return home, following which they filed a complaint at Kurlap police station in Sangli district. On Wednesday afternoon, his body was found hanging from a tree in a farm.

The Maharashtra State Contractor Association slammed the state government alleging that it has been consistently raising the pending dues worth Rs 85,000 crore for more than two years which were neglected by the state government. The association also released documents showing Patil had submitted the construction work.

"When I heard the news, I took information from the concerned officials. There was no record of pending dues. We do not know if he had submitted the work from any other contractor," said State's Water Supply and Sanitation minister, Gulabrao Patil.

Milind Bhosle, president, Maharashtra State Contractor Association, said that large number of small engineers had taken contracts of Jal Jeevan Mission work and the government has not paid their dues.

"There are dues worth Rs 89,000 crore pending and we have been consistently speaking about it. But nobody from the government gave any attention to it. This has now resulted in the suicide of a young contractor. He had also taken loan worth Rs 65 lakh and couldn't repay it since the government did not pay the dues," said Bhosle.

Opposition NCP(SP) leader Jayant Patil said that he had warned the state government in his speech at the legislative assembly about such possibility.

"I had warned the possibility of contractors committing suicides. But the government paid no attention to it," he said. Harshal Patil was a resident of Walwa taluka in Sangli, the home district of Jayant Patil.

Congress MLA Vijay Wadeti was said that after farmers' protests are commencing suicides in the state. "The government is responsible for his death. The state has gone bankrupt and there is no one from the government who is looking after it," he said.

IN MAY this year, Republican Sena president Anandraj Ambedkar said he was willing to set aside his differences with his elder brother and Nandhi Babujan Aghadi (VBA) chief Prakash Ambedkar, saying "If Uddhav Thackeray and Raj Thackeray could come together, why can't the Ambedkar family do it?"

Two months down the line, Anandraj and Prakash, grandsons of R Ambedkar, are caught in a verbal duel with any possibility of their reconciliation peering over now. This was apparently triggered by Anandraj's decision last week to join hands with Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister and Shiv Sena established Ekath Shinde for the local body elections slated for later this year.

The Shiv Sena is a key constituent of the BJP-led Maharashtra government and its ally who is looking after it," he said.

Following Anandraj's move, Prakash asked the VBA activists and supporters to counter Dalit outcastes aligned with the BJP/RSS, openly or tacitly, while using B R Ambedkar's name.

Raising objection to Anandraj's move, Prakash said, "The threat" to the Constitution under the ruling BJP-led NDA, Prakash has alleged that the Republican Sena's alliance with the Shiv Sena not only undercuts the fight against BJP and its allies to save Constitution, but also against the ideology of Phule-Shahu-Ambedkar, the VBA chief claimed.

"It is now up to followers of Phule, Shahu and Ambedkar whether they want to stand with a puppet of BJP/RSS whose ideology is to replace the Constitution with Manusmriti, or to stand with someone whose ideology is to uphold and defend the Constitution," Prakash said.

Hitting back, Anandraj said, "Republican Sena has forged an alliance with Shiv Sena on a common agenda of welfare of oppressed and backward classes. We have not joined BJP/RSS. So where is the question of compromising our ideology. We are committed to Ambedkar's teaching and principles."

The rising tension between Prakash and Anandraj seems to have derailed the possibility of

their reunion. A senior VBA leader close to the Ambedkar family said, "The Dalit leaders championing the cause of social justice and welfare of oppressed have failed to unite and work as a team. Unfortunately, everyone wants to become a leader. And it became easier to establish parties in both the ruling and Opposition camps to exploit this weakness to their advantage."

RPI splinter outfits
The Republican Party of India (RPI) was founded by B R Ambedkar in September 1956, which evolved after the dissolution of the All India Scheduled Castes Federation.

Over the decades the RPI disintegrated into several breakaway outfits, including the RPI (A) led by Union minister Ramdas Athawale, RPI (Gawal), RPI (Kawade) and RPI (Kholgrade).

There had been attempts in the late 1990s to unite various RPI factions. Coming on a common platform, they fought the 1998 Lok Sabha elections together in alliance with the Congress, getting four seats won by Prakash Ambedkar, Ramdas Athawale, Ramakrishna Gawal and Jogendra Kawade.

Their joint RPI from however unravelled after some time. In 2009, their another attempt to unite failed.

Ambedkar grandsons
Since his student days, Prakash Ambedkar had been part of the RPI. In 1994, he invited the party to form his outfit Bharat Babujan Mahasangan, which evolved into the VBA in 2018.

Anandraj broke away from the RPI to float the Republican Sena in 1998. Although based on Ambedkar's philosophy like other RPI factions, the Republican Sena has a limited presence in the state. It is known for having a base among Dalits and marginalised, especially in pockets of Mumbai and some

places in the Vidarbha region.

In contrast, Prakash has been noted in state politics for several decades and has a wider acceptance and larger socio-political network across the regions.

In November 2022, Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray joined hands with Prakash Ambedkar, asserting that they came together to save the Constitution and democracy, which had been facing a "threat", he alleged, from the BJP dispensation.

An ally of the Opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA), Uddhav's alliance with Prakash however fell through ahead of the 2024 Lok Sabha and Assembly elections. The VBA contested in these polls alone, failing to open its account.

"Shinde earlier tried to join hands with Prakash Ambedkar. He wanted VBA to become an ally of the Maharashtra in 2024 Lok Sabha and Assembly polls. However, Prakash preferred to go solo in these polls."

Besides his critics, even a section of the Shiv Sena believe that Prakash has not been able to lead the community effectively. Even in the 2019 Lok Sabha and Assembly polls, the VBA, contesting alone, had drawn a blank. It was said to have hurt the prospects of the then Opposition Congress-NCP coalition in several seats by causing a division of "secular votes" between them.

Shinde, Anandraj alliance

The Shiv Sena has allied with the Republican Sena with a view to boosting its prospects in the upcoming local body elections, getting four seats won by Prakash Ambedkar, Ramdas Athawale, Ramakrishna Gawal and Jogendra Kawade.

Their joint RPI from however unravelled after some time. In 2009, their another attempt to unite failed.

Shinde's support base beyond Maharashtra is limited. For his part, Anandraj is looking to find his feet in state politics through this alliance in the local body polls. He said, "The alliance is for the welfare of oppressed segments. It would also provide a platform to them to participate in power."

Nashik court grants bail to Rahul Gandhi in defamation case over remarks about Savarkar

Mumbai: A court in Maharashtra's Nashik city on Thursday granted bail to Congress leader Rahul Gandhi in a defamation case filed against him for remarks about Hinduva ideology and freedom fighter V D Savarkar during the Bharat Jodo Yatra in 2022.

Appearing through video link before additional chief judicial magistrate R Chavadas, Gandhi, the leader of opposition in the Lok Sabha, pleaded "not guilty".

Nashik-resident Devendra Bhutadai, through his lawyer Manoj Pingale, has filed the criminal defamation case under sections 500 (defamation) and 504 (intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of the peace) of the Indian Penal Code.

After Gandhi pleaded not guilty, his lawyers sought bail. The court allowed the plea on a bond of Rs 15,000, said advocate Pingale.

The complainant, director of an NGO, alleged that Gandhi, at a press conference in Hingoli and in a speech during his yatra in November 2022, made statements that harmed Savarkar's reputation. PTI

Traffic constable on duty hit by crane vehicle dies in Mahape

A 41-YEAR-OLD traffic police constable of Navi Mumbai police died after he was allegedly hit by a moving crane vehicle, on duty in the Mahape area of Navi Mumbai Thursday afternoon.

Traffic cop Ganesh Patil was attached to the Mahape traffic unit and was maintaining traffic flow near Mahape bridge.

According to the police sources, at around 12.30 pm the hanging iron hook of the hydra crane vehicle, which was positioned at the spot, struck the constable, who was being driven rashly by its operator, hit Patil, who fell down and came under its front wheels. Patil sustained serious injuries prompting his colleague policemen to rush him to Vashi civil hospital, where he was declared dead before admission.

His body was sent for post-mortem examination. The crane driver Rajesh Gound was detained and was handed over to the Turbhe MIDC police station which subsequently arrested him, said a police officer. He was charged him with relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and the Motor Vehicles Act. Police have sent his blood sample for tests, and their reports are awaited.

Gound, a native of Uttar Pradesh, resides in Dombivli and was taking the crane from Rabale MIDC towards Turbhe.

Rs 512 cr co-op bank fraud: Court orders auction of two properties of former MLA

A SPECIAL court has ordered auction of two properties linked to former MLA Vivekanand Shankar Patil to facilitate repayment to creditors of a cooperative bank based in Panvel in Maharashtra.

These properties, comprising a multi-acre sports academy and a land parcel in Panvel, have been attached by probate agencies in an alleged fraud of over Rs 512 crore at the Karnala Nagari Sahakari (cooperative) Bank.

Patil, the prime accused in the case, represented Panvel in Maharashtra's Legislative Assembly from 2013 to 2018 and was a legislator from Uran once.

As of 87 properties, including some ancestral property of Patil, were attached under the MFD Act by Navi Mumbai police's Economic Offences Wing, The ED, which is also probing a case linked to the fraud, too has dual attachment to some of these properties.

Decision on Kokate after meeting him next week, says Ajit Pawar

Prisoner caught with mobile hidden inside jail in Beed

Purandar Airport: Besides compensation, govt to give land owners developed plot in Aerocity

LAND ACQUISITION for the proposed International Airport in Purandar, has entered a crucial phase with a joint inspection of the land to be acquired to be scheduled soon, state government officials said. The state government has also worked out a special plan where farmers who willingly give their consent will be allotted developed plots equivalent to 10 per cent of their total surrendered land in the proposed Aerocity area, along

with compensation. A senior official of the state government told The Indian Express said work for the acquisition is going according to plan.

"The government is now set to conduct a survey, which will involve both the landowner and the surveyor assessing the designated land together. Following this joint survey, the actual amount of land to be acquired will be determined," said the official.

Speaking about the special plan, the official said, "Developed plots will be given only for farmers who give their consent. Those who oppose the land ac-

quisition will get only compensation. We hope this move will allow more and more farmers to give their consent."

Spread over 2,832 hectares, the proposed international airport will require the acquisition of land from seven villages: Vampur, Uda-chitavi, Kumbharvalan, Ekhaturpur, Munjharva, Khanwadi, and Pargan. The project has faced protests from local residents in many parts. However, the state government has attempted to alleviate the farmers' concerns and promised them substantial compensation.

Among the protesters, Pargan residents have been the most vociferous in their opposition to the project as it will see the highest land acquisition. Mahesh Mergane, a villager from Pargan, said, "At present, we have not seen any activity on the ground. We do not require any developed land, we will not allow the land acquisition." The need for another international airport in Pune has long been recognised, as the Lohegaon airport is overburdened. The Lohegaon airport served primarily as a defence base, owned by the Indian Air Force and operated by the Airports Authority of India (AAI).
