Sir/Madam,

This has reference to your online proposal no. IA/MH/CRZ/488372/2024 dated 18/07/2024 on the above-mentioned project proposal for CRZ Clearance, in accordance with the provisions of the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Notification, 2019 and as amended thereof issued under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

2. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has examined the proposal for CRZ Clearance for 'Upgradation of Existing 110 KV Kalwa-kalyan Transmission Line to 220 KV Level, District Thane, Maharashtra by M/s The Tata Power Company Limited'.

3. The proposal was considered by the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) for Infrastructure Development, Coastal Regulation Zone, Building/Construction and Miscellaneous projects, in its 378th meeting held on 28/10/2024. The Project Proponent (M/s The Tata Power Company Limited) along with his EIA consultant (M/s Ultra Tech, Environmental Consultancy & Laboratory) have made a presentation on above said proposal and informed the following salient features of the proposal, including the details provided in the application of the project, to EAC:

1.	Brief description of the Project	The proposal seeks CRZ Clearance as per CRZ Notification 2019 for Upgradation of Existing 110 KV Kalwa-kalyan Transmission Line to 220 KV Level, District Thane, Maharashtra by M/s The Tata Power Company Limited																
2.	<p>Salient features / Components of the project activity:</p> <p>The proposed project includes upgradation of existing 110 kV double circuit transmission line to 220 kV multi circuit transmission line using the same Right of Way of 22 m and land area. The existing transmission line has 87 towers and the same number of new towers will be constructed at the same location beside existing one. Over the length of 17 km, the transmission traverses through CRZ area at Dawala, Khardipada, Domkhar, Mothi Desai and Nilje village. Total 2 no. of towers are in the CRZ zone and transmission line between some towers passes through CRZ zone, so the clearance is needed.</p> <p>Thane is one of the few districts in the state of Maharashtra with a developed industrial sector. Over half of the district's social and economic development may be attributed to industrialization. In terms of population, it ranks third in the state according to the 2011 census. From Kalwa to Kalyan, Tata Power Company Limited currently operates a 110 kV transmission line. This existing transmission line is over 75 years old and crosses through the Thane District, Parsik Hill and Forest Land.</p> <p>This transmission line carries electricity from the Tata Power Bhivpuri Hydro Power Station to the Mumbai Metropolitan Area. The ongoing infrastructural development in and around the Kalyan sector of the Mumbai Suburban area is responsible for an annual load increase rate of 6%.</p> <p>The present 110 kV level must be raised to a 220 kV level in order to support Kalyan's present and future load needs. The Hon'ble Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission's rules were followed by Tata Power when they suggested replacing the existing 110 kV double circuit Kalwa-Kalyan line corridor with a 220 kV multi circuit Kalwa-Kalyan line. There is need of the proposed upgradation to support the demand of continuous growing population and to ensure the uninterrupted power supply.</p>

The proposed transmission & distribution schemes not only improve overall power supply situation but also improve reliability, quality, security and enhancement of power supply in the region. The augmentation undertaken by utilities would also serve to meet the increasing power demand envisaged in Thane and nearby area due to emerging developmental activities in the area.
40.	SCZMA Recommendation (mention the recommendation letter Number and date)	The Maharashtra SCZMA has recommended the proposal to Ministry <i>vide</i> letter No. IA/MH/CRZ/488372/2024, dated 05/09/2024 and 21/08/2025, as per CRZ Notification 2019.

4. The Committee has deliberated the proposal based on the information provided/presented by the proponent. After deliberation, the Committee noted that the project activity is permissible as per CRZ Notification, 2019 and Maharashtra CZMA has recommended the proposal *vide* letter dated 05/09/2024. The Committee has also noted that despite no change in area estimate in CRZ area, the overall area estimate, presented in the CRZ report, EIA report and SCZMA recommendation letter is not similar. So, the Committee directed the proponent to submit the revised recommendation letter from MCZMA, submit same to the Ministry for record and Ministry process file for CRZ Clearance as per procedure. The Committee also suggested the Bird diverters of international standard should be installed at all sites with consultation of reputed institute in the field. Further, considering the diversion of 4.5773 ha of forest land is involved, the Committee has directed that PP should obtain necessary prior clearance as per Forest Conservation Act, 1980 before commencing the construction of the project activity. The Committed has also opined that if required, necessary clearance should be obtained from Hon'ble High Court of Bombay & NOC from Mangrove Cell before cutting of mangroves. In response, proponent has agreed the same.

5. The Committee after detailed deliberations and considering the submissions made by the project proponent recommended the proposal for CRZ Clearance as per CRZ Notification 2019 subject to terms and conditions, as stipulated during its 378th meeting held on 28/10/2024.

6. As directed by the EAC in its 378th meeting held on 28/10/2024, an ADS was raised on 02/11/2024 to the project proponent for submission of a revised recommendation letter from MCZMA, required for further processing of the proposal. In response, the proponent has submitted the revised recommendation letter dated 21/08/2025 through PARIVESH on 24/08/2025.

7. Based on the recommendation of the Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority and considering the submissions made by the project proponent, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, in acceptance of the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee (CRZ), hereby accords CRZ Clearance to the project for **'Upgradation of Existing 110 KV Kalwa-kalyan Transmission Line to 220 KV Level, District Thane, Maharashtra by M/s The Tata Power Company Limited'** under the provisions of the CRZ Notification, 2019 and amendments thereto, subject to the compliance of terms and conditions as under:-

Specific Conditions

S. No	Specific Conditions
1	All construction shall be strictly in accordance with the provisions of the CRZ Notification, 2019, as amended from time to time.
2	The Bird diverters of international standard should be installed at all sites with consultation of reputed institute in the field.
3	PP should obtain necessary prior clearance as per Forest Conservation Act, 1980 before commencing the construction of the project activity.
4	If any mangrove destruction involves, prior permission from Hon'ble High Court of Bombay should be taken for cutting of mangrove tree as directed <i>vide</i> order dated 17/09/2018 in the matter PIL no. 87 of 2006 before start construction of the project.
5	All the necessary precautions for general safety and health aspects of people/labour as per the existing norms should be considered during construction and operation phase.
6	During the construction phase as well as operational phase, water flow of adjacent creek should not be diverted or stopped.
7	All the mitigation measures listed in the EIA report should be implemented without any deviations.
8	Permanent labour camp, machinery and material storage shall not be set up in the CRZ area.
9	Any temporary physical infrastructure setup and excavated material during construction shall not be disposed in water bodies or adjacent areas and the site shall be restored to its original condition after completion of construction of work.
10	No groundwater shall be extracted within the CRZ area to meet the water requirements during the construction and/or operation phase of the project. Provisions for suitable rainwater harvesting should be made and implemented.
11	Temporary toilets will be provided for all construction labour. Suitable toilet fixtures for water conservation shall be provided. Fixtures for showers, toilet flushing and drinking should be of low flow either by use of aerators of pressure reducing devices or sensor based control.
12	Topsoil excavated during construction activities shall be stored for use in horticulture/landscape development etc. within the project site.
13	Water quality of the entire creek should be monitored regularly to see the impact of construction and reclamation activities and submit the report to IRO of the Ministry.
14	Construction material and structures/scaffoldings erected for construction at site shall be cleared immediately after finishing construction and it shall be ensured that no construction waste, garbage and machinery or equipment are left post construction.

S. No	Specific Conditions
15	All the conditions stipulated by the Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority for CRZ clearance under CRZ Notification, 2019 vide its letter no IA/MH/CRZ/488372/2024, dated 05/09/2024 and 21/08/2025 and commitments made by the PP before the MCZMA and EAC shall be followed in letter and spirit.
16	All necessary clearance from the concerned authority, as may be applicable should be obtained prior to commencement of project or activity.

General Conditions

S. No	General Conditions
1	Management of solid waste in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 shall be strictly implemented.
2	'Consent to Establish' and /or 'Consent to Operate' shall be obtained from State Pollution Control Board under the provisions of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and / or the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, as may be applicable.
3	Disposal of muck during construction phase should not create any adverse effect on the neighbouring communities and be disposed taking the necessary precautions for general safety and health aspects of people, only in approved sites with the approval of Competent Authority.
4	All liquid waste arising from the proposed development will be disposed of as per the norms prescribed by Central / State Pollution Control Board. There shall not be any disposal of untreated effluent into the sea / coastal water bodies. It shall be ensured that the wastewater generated is treated in the STP as committed by the project proponent. The treated waste water shall be reused for landscaping, flushing and / or HVAC cooling purposes etc. within the development. The project proponent should also make alternate arrangement for situation arising due to malfunctioning of STP. There shall be regular monitoring of standard parameters of the effluent discharge from STP under intimation to the SPCB.
5	Any hazardous waste generated during construction phase, shall be disposed off as per applicable rules and norms with necessary approvals of the State Pollution Control Board.
6	A copy of the clearance letter shall be uploaded on the website of the concerned State Coastal Zone Management Authority/State Pollution Control Board. The Clearance letter shall also be displayed at the Regional Office, District Industries Centre and Collector's Office/ Tehsildar's office for 30 days.
7	A six-monthly monitoring report shall need to be submitted by the project proponent to the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry regarding the implementation of the stipulated conditions.
8	The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change or any other Competent Authority

	may stipulate any additional conditions or modify the existing ones, if necessary in the interest of environment and the same shall be complied with.
9	Full co-operation shall be extended to the officials from the Regional Office of MoEF&CC, during monitoring of implementation of environmental safeguards stipulated. It shall be ensured that documents/data sought pertinent is made available to the monitoring team. A complete set of all the documents submitted to MoEF&CC shall be forwarded to the concerned Regional Office of MoEF&CC.
10	In the case of any change(s) in the scope of the project, the project would require a fresh appraisal by this Ministry.
11	The Ministry reserves the right to add additional safeguard measures subsequently, if considered necessary, and to take action to ensure effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures in a time bound and satisfactory manner, including revoking of the environment clearance under the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, for non-compliance.
12	All other statutory clearances such as the approvals for storage of diesel from Chief Controller of Explosives, Fire Department, Civil Aviation Department, Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 etc. shall be obtained, as applicable by project proponent from the respective Competent Authorities.
13	The project proponent should advertise in at least two local Newspapers widely circulated in the region, one of which shall be in the vernacular language informing that the project has been accorded CRZ Clearance and copies of clearance letters are available with the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) and may also be seen on the website of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change at https://parivesh.nic.in/ . The advertisement should be made within Seven days from the date of receipt of the Clearance letter and a copy of the same should be forwarded to the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry.
14	A copy of the clearance letter shall be sent by the proponent to concerned Panchayat, Zilla Parisad/Municipal Corporation, Urban Local Body and the Local NGO, if any, from whom suggestions/ representations, if any, were received while processing the proposal.
15	The proponent shall upload the status of compliance of the stipulated conditions, including results of monitored data on their website and shall update the same periodically. It shall simultaneously be sent to the Regional Office of MoEF&CC, the respective Zonal Office of CPCB and the SPCB.
16	The environmental statement for each financial year ending 31st March in Form-V as is mandated to be submitted by the project proponent to the concerned State Pollution Control Board as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, as amended subsequently, shall also be put on the website of the project proponent along with the status of compliance of clearance conditions and shall also be sent to the respective Regional Office of the Ministry by e-mail.

8. This Clearance is subject to final order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Goa Foundation Vs Union of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No.460 of 2004 as may be applicable to this project.

9. The Ministry reserves the right to stipulate additional conditions, if found necessary at subsequent stages and the project proponent shall implement all the said conditions in a time bound manner. The Ministry may revoke or suspend the CRZ clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not found satisfactory.

10. Concealing factual data or submission of false/fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned above may result in withdrawal of this clearance and attract action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

11. Any appeal against this CRZ clearance shall lie with the National Green Tribunal, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 16 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010.

12. The above conditions shall be enforced, *inter-alia* under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 along with their amendments and Rules and any other orders passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/High Courts and any other Court of Law relating to the subject matter.

13. This is issued with the approval of the Competent Authority.

THE BOMBAY High Court on Thursday directed the Special Investigation Team (SIT) appointed by the Mumbai Police to handover to Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) the probe into death of Sion resident Vijay Singh, who died of alleged police

torture in October, 2019. The SIT is directed to handover the probe papers and records to CBI within 15 days. The Court also laid down 10-point guidelines for the central agency to conduct the probe and left it to the agency to decide on registering an FIR in the matter. A division bench of Justice Ravindra V Ghuge and Gautam A Ankhad passed a verdict on a plea

filed by Hriday Narayan Singh and other family members of late Vijay Singh in 2020 through advocate Vinay V Nair seeking investigation into the death. The Police had claimed that Vijay Singh, along with his two friends were taken to Police station after their spat with a couple near his residence while he was parking his motorcycle. Thereafter, as per police, he was kept in the lockup for some time, after which he complained of chest pain and collapsed at the police station. He was rushed to Sion hospital, where he was declared brought dead. His family members alleged that Vijay died due to police excess or torture. The five policemen who were present at the police station were then suspended. The family also claimed that the postmortem report of the civic-run KEM Hospital indicated that Singh had died due to contusion to the chest, but no action was taken against the police officials. The government said departmental enquiries were conducted against the officers involved and after the SIT completed the investigation and found that none of them were responsible, they were reinstated.
