Mumbai Operation area is spread from Colaba to Bhayander and Vikhroli to Madh Island. However, this area is further bifurcated in 6 zones.

While we can arrange an additional vehicle for emergencies, we are unable to provide a substitute engineer if our primary engineer is on leave.	For short leave 1day in a month with advance notice can be made up easily by working on weekends. However, for long leave more than 1 day vendor has to provide alternate Engineers along with technician, 4-wheeler with driver.

8	Service Level Agreement (SLA) & Penalty clause Page No.26 (Number of meters tested perday)	Minimum 5-meter tests per team perday as per TPC schedule	If multiple zones are scheduled for the same day, it may not be possible to attend all of them as specified. In the event that we attend a minimum of five cases but some remain pending, please clarify if a penalty will be applicable.	5 cases per day is the minimum requirement to avoid penalty and to qualify for billing as per the MoQ defined. It shall be the endeavour of the vendor to attend and complete maximum cases as possible in a day. However, waiver of the penalty will be at sole discretion of Tata Power, provided the team is meeting the SLAs and has worked for entire 9 hours continuously during daytime.

Rest all details remain same as per the NIT published on 10th April 2026 for this tender.

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
