1. INTRODUCTION:

The Tata Power Company Limited (TPCL) is among the largest private sector Power Utility companies in India with presence in Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Power through conventional and renewable sources.

Mundra Thermal Power Station (A Tata Power Division) has implemented the 4150 MW UMPP near the port city of Mundra in the state of Gujarat in India. This UMPP is India's first 830 MW unit thermal power plant using supercritical technology. MTPS operates on imported coal on pulverized coal-based boiler technology. The generating plant is in Tunda village of Mundra district in the state of Gujarat, India.

The tendering activities for this Project are being managed from Tata Power's following Office:

2. SCOPE OF WORK:

➤ General Specification

- General civil work shall be carried out within the plant premises.
- Vendor has to submit detailed schedule activity plan mobilization and completion period to complete the work within validity of contract during submitting their offer.
- Before commencing the work, vendor has to submit detailed Quality Assurance plan (with standard test to be performed & frequency of the same during execution of work), work procedures & method statement along with MSDS (Material safety data sheet) to QC department & get it approved.
- Vendor has to execute the work as per approved QAP & has to take the necessary clearance from M/s MTPS concern department at every stage of work.
- Vendor has to execute the work as per M/s MTPS standard safety practices & as directed by EIC from time to time. JSA/HIRA has to submit to safety Department for review & approval.
- Before bidding the Bidder to visit the MTPS Power Plant to study the actual working conditions, before submitting their offer. The Bidders shall examine the site of works and its surroundings and see for himself that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a contract.
- Working time will be from 9.00 AM to 6.00 PM from Monday to Saturday. Sunday will be holiday.
- Quantities of individual items may be revised during contract period based on site requirement. Contractor shall not be entitled for any compensation on ground of such alteration in scope of work. MTPS reserves the right to operate or increase/decrease quantities in each item or omit any item included in Schedule of Quantity at his discretion. Contractor shall have no claim, what so ever, on grounds of loss of anticipated profit etc. on account of the same.
- The quantities specified are only estimated and it may get vary at any stage during contract period, so contractor is required to carry out the scope of work as per the time-to-time instructions provided by Engineer-in-charge of MTPS.
- The scope of work includes supply of all materials as per the items nomenclature given in schedule of items quantity which is inclusive of all materials, labour, supervision, tools & tackles, and required scaffolding, man lifter, equipment's, consumables, transportation, loading, unloading, safe & none obstructing storage, all necessary auxiliary & ancillary works which are not specified herein but required to carry out for satisfactory and timely completion of entire scope of work as specified.
- Electricity will be provided by MTPS free of cost at site. Electric point at one point nearest available source from the work site will be provided, from there onwards vendor has to manage by their own for further points if required.
- All the electrical tools / tackles / appliances / machines have to be certified by MTPS EMD department before usage of the same.
- One qualified safety officer to be deployed by vendor on full time basis throughout the work.
- Qualified & experienced Foreman/ staff/ Engineer of subject knowledge/Experience to be deployed by vendor on full time basis throughout the work.
- During working time one four-wheeler vehicle should be deployed at site dedicated for full time at site.
- The entire scope of work shall be completed within **4 (Four) months** from the date of issuance of the Purchase Order (PO).

➤ **A. Precast Trench Cover M20 Grade:**

- The supply, transportation, and installation of precast concrete covers shall be entirely within the Vendor's scope of work.
- Reinforcement steel for the precast concrete covers shall be measured and paid under a separate BOQ item.
- All consumables, lifting tools, tackles, and other accessories required for execution of the work shall be provided by the Vendor at no additional cost.
- Loading, unloading, transportation, handling, and installation of the precast concrete covers shall be the Vendor's responsibility.
- If cleaning and cutting of babool vegetation is required for execution of the work, the same shall be entirely within the Vendor's scope. The Vendor shall be responsible for cutting, cleaning, collection, transportation, and disposal of the dried vegetation as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC), its transportation and disposal (Control Fire) after drying, and implementation of all necessary fire prevention and control measures during the activity shall be entirely within the Vendor's scope of work.
- No separate payment shall be made for any equipment, machinery, or plant required for execution of the work. The cost of all such equipment shall be deemed to be included in the quoted rates.
- During replacement of existing precast concrete covers, the removal, handling, loading, transportation, and disposal of the old/damaged precast concrete covers shall be entirely within the Vendor's scope of work. Disposal of the removed materials shall be carried out as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC). No separate payment shall be made for these activities.
- The precast concrete covers shall be manufactured by a reputed and approved manufacturer, such as Himalaya or an equivalent brand, subject to the approval of the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC). The precast concrete covers shall conform to the specified quality standards, dimensions, strength, and applicable codes and specifications.
- The design, dimensions, reinforcement details, drawings, and other technical specifications for the precast concrete covers shall be provided by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC). The Vendor shall manufacture and install the precast concrete covers strictly in accordance with the approved drawings and instructions issued by the EIC.
- During removal of the existing precast concrete covers, the Vendor shall sort the removed precast units as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC). Any precast concrete covers found to be in reusable or good condition shall be carefully handled, transported, and stored at the location designated by the EIC. Damaged or unserviceable precast concrete covers shall be disposed of strictly as directed by the EIC. No separate payment shall be made for sorting, handling, transportation, storage, or disposal of the removed precast concrete covers.

➤ **B. Reinforcement Bars:**

- The Vendor shall prepare and submit the Bar Bending Schedule (BBS) for approval by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC) prior to commencement of the work. No reinforcement fabrication, cutting, bending, or installation shall be carried out until the BBS has been reviewed and approved by the EIC.

- Reinforcement steel shall be procured from approved and reputed manufacturers such as Jindal, Tata Steel, or an equivalent brand, subject to the approval of the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).
- **Dimensions and Tolerances:** All precast concrete covers shall be manufactured strictly as per the approved drawings, dimensions, reinforcement details, and tolerances given by EIC. Any deviation shall require prior approval from the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).
- **Protection of Existing Facilities:** The Vendor shall take adequate precautions to protect nearby structures, underground utilities, pipelines, cable trenches, equipment, and other existing facilities.
- **Housekeeping:** The Vendor shall maintain good housekeeping throughout the execution of the work. All debris, waste materials, removed concrete covers, packing materials, and scrap generated during the work shall be removed regularly and disposed of as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).
- **Quality of Precast Covers:** The precast concrete covers shall be free from cracks, honeycombing, and other visible defects. Damaged or rejected precast covers shall be replaced by the Vendor at no additional cost.

Safety requirement (As per Tata Power safety guidelines):

- No jobs to be carried out without PTWs, Toolbox meeting (TBM) and prior instructions from Tata Power. Any revisions/changes if required to be done for job execution, shall be informed to concerned tata Power engineer beforehand to avoid any delay in execution.
- Contractor safety supervisor is required to guide the workmen all the time of activity.
- 4 PPEs compliance is mandatory requirement for Tata Power site.
- All lifting tools & tackles shall be certified with competent authority.

Note: Tata Power reserves the right of revisions/changes in the job scope whenever required and the same shall be intimated to contractor.

3. TENDER FEE & TIMELINES:

- a. Interested parties meeting the "Bidder Pre-Qualification Requirements" specified under point no. 4 in this document can request tender document and participate in the bidding process by submitting the Expression of Interest (EOI) Letter along with the Tender Fee Payment Details to the contact details mentioned below not later than the deadline specified below. Request for extension of EOI submission date will be not entertained.

- d. **Expression of Interest letter to be submitted along with tender fee payment details should include the following details:**
- A covering letter duly stamped and signed by an authorized signatory clearly indicating the Tender Reference number and your EOI to participate in the tendering process.
 - Tender fee payment details / reference number (ensure that tender fee is received by us within specified deadline)
 - Bidder to indicate authorized person name, contact number and e-mail id (mandatory) of the person to whom RFQ / tender and all other communications to be addressed for this tender.
- e. Detailed Bid Document (also referred as RFQ) shall be issued through Tata Power e-tender portal (Ariba System) only to the parties submitting a valid EOI as per the terms mentioned in this document.

4. BIDDER PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Interested parties to note that Bidder shall be required to fulfill the following bidder pre-qualification requirement / criteria to qualify for the subject work. Bidder will be required to submit relevant supporting documents to demonstrate their qualification during the bid submission stage against Tender document / RFQ and bidders not found meeting the pre-qualification requirements given below will be disqualified from the tender.

4.1 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT:

- 4.1.1 The Bidder must have **a minimum of 5 years of experience** in executing **similar types of work**, specifically related to **Heavy duty factory made precast articles including concrete covers supply & installation**, in industrial, infrastructure, or operating plant settings. **(Agency to attach Certificates /Completion certificate / Work order copy etc...).**

- 4.1.2 Bidder should provide minimum two references for having successfully completed the similar type of work like **Heavy precast concrete articles / cover supply & installation** etc... Of minimum Rs.75 lac (Indian Rupees Seventy-five lacs only) Or above in last two years. **(Attach Certificate of Experience and Satisfactory Completion of work awarded from concerned Establishments / Companies along with unpriced copy of PO to ascertain the work nature)**
- 4.1.3 Bidder should furnish List of Clients for whom they have done similar work like **Heavy duty precast articles including concrete covers supply & installation**, during the last three financial years i.e., FY 2023 -2024, FY 2024 -25, and FY 2025-26 as per nature of contract. **(Attach Certificates from concerned)**
- 4.1.4 Bidder / Tenderer should preferably have ISO 9001 / ISO 14001 / ISO 45001 certification or must give an undertaking for its willingness to obtain the same within 2 months of qualification for the bidding.

It may be noted that the above requirements are minimum qualification criteria. However, Tata Power reserves its right to further assess the capabilities of the parties and reserves its rights to further shortlist, accept or reject any party without assigning any reason

4.2 FINANCIAL REQUIREMENT:

Bidder / Tenderer should have minimum Average Annual Turn-over of Rs. 100 Lakhs (Indian Rupees one Hundred Lakhs only) during the last 3 financial years **(Attach Certificate from Chartered Accountant in this regard)**

It may be noted that the above requirements are minimum qualification criteria. However, Tata Power reserves its right to further assess the capabilities of the parties and reserves its rights to further shortlist, accept or reject any party without assigning any reason.

5. BID SECURITY / EMD:

Interested parties to note that Bidder will be required to furnish a Bid Security along with their Bid, in the format prescribed in Bid Document **in the form of Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft or RTGS**, for an amount as defined in the covering page of this notice document. Bids not accompanied by an acceptable Bid Security shall be rejected by the Owner as being non-responsive and returned to the bidder without being opened.

Interested parties to note that Bid Security is not required with the EOI and it is required to be submitted with the Bid only during Bid Submission stage once RFQ is released to the interested parties that have submitted a valid EOI.

6. BIDDING PROCESS:

Detailed Bid Document (also referred as RFQ) shall be issued through Tata Power e-tender portal (Ariba System) only to the parties that submitted a valid EOI as per terms mentioned in this document.

Bidder to note that commercials for subject tender may be conducted through e-auction.
Detailed bidding and auction process shall be detailed in the RFQ / tender document.
